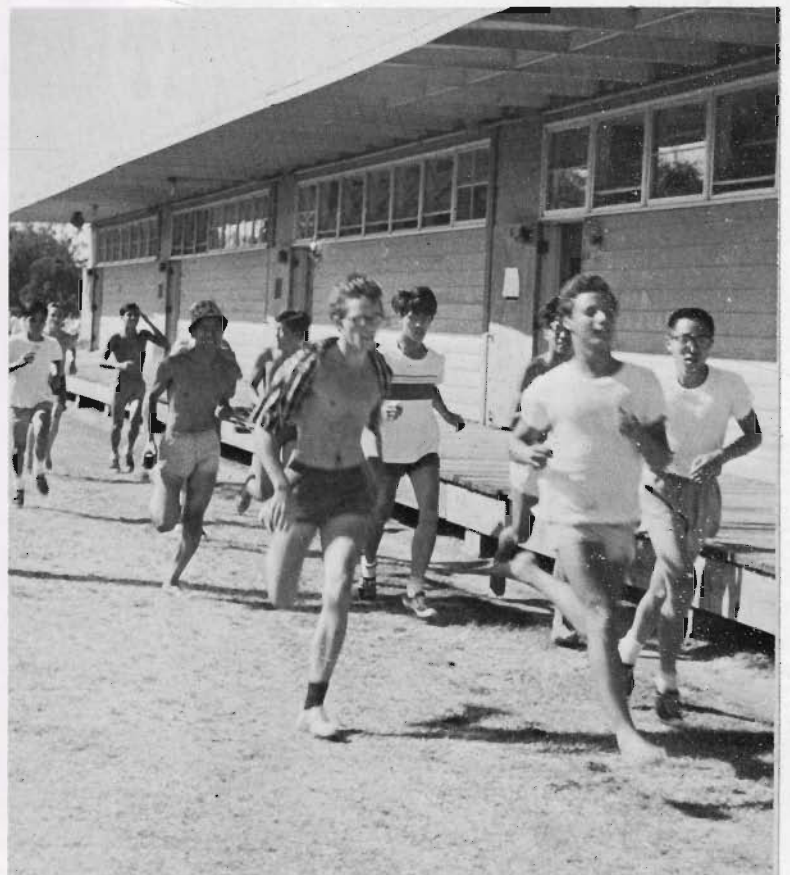

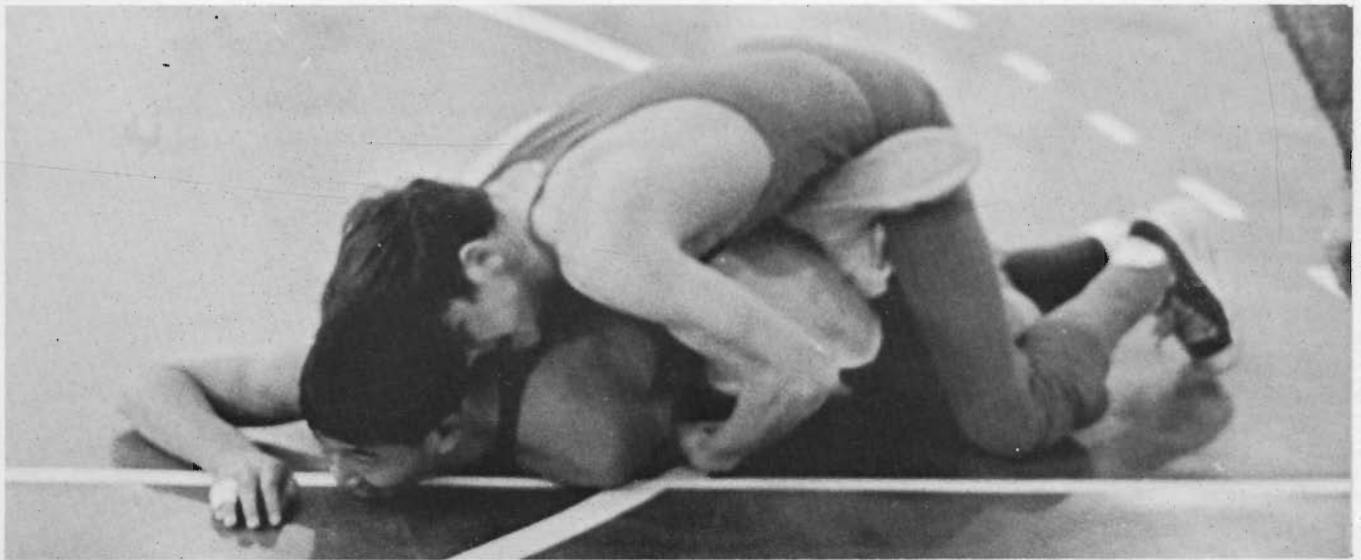

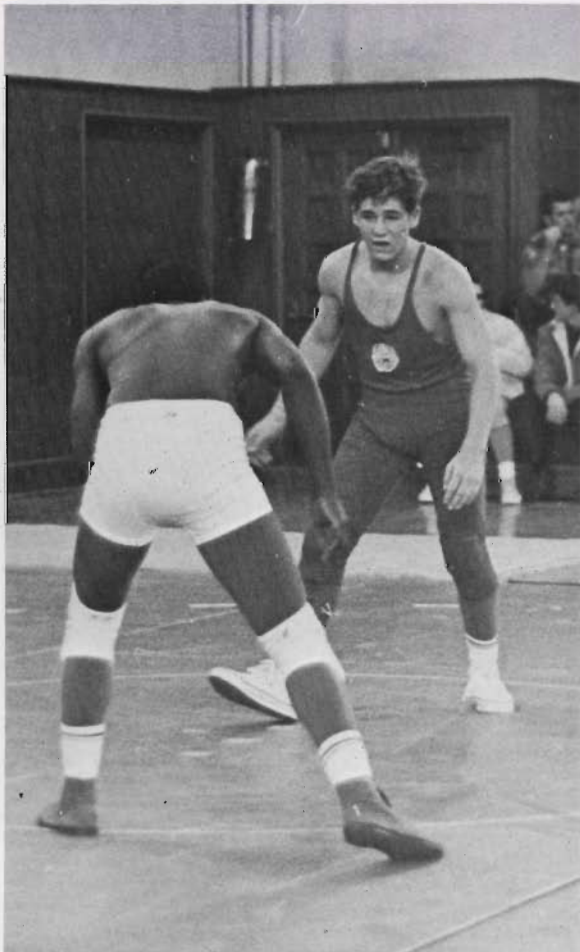

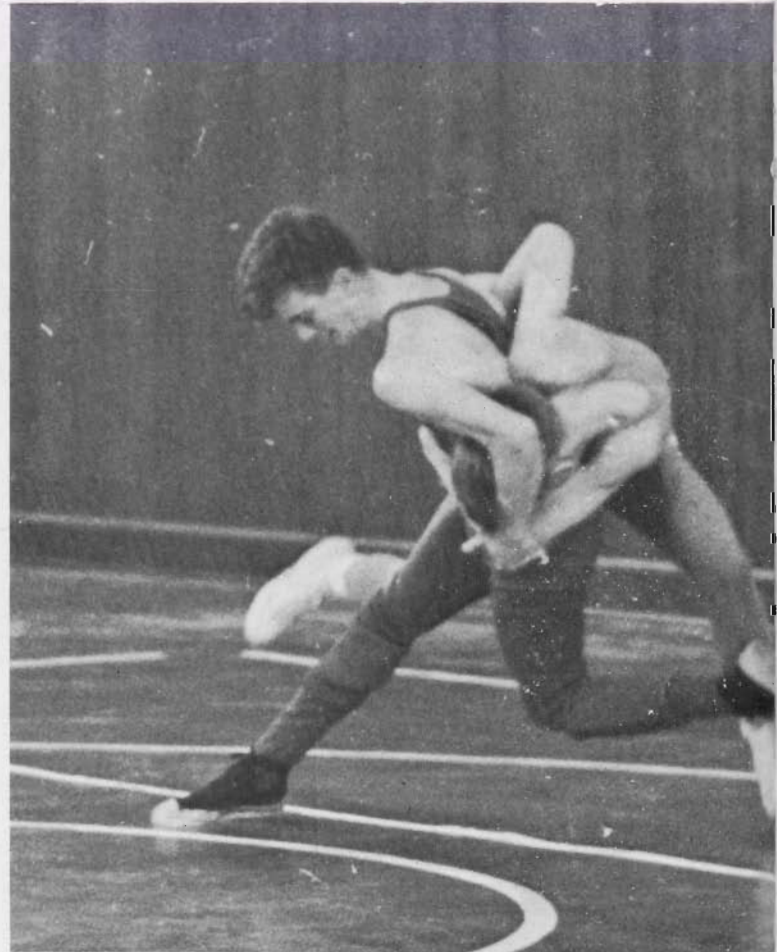

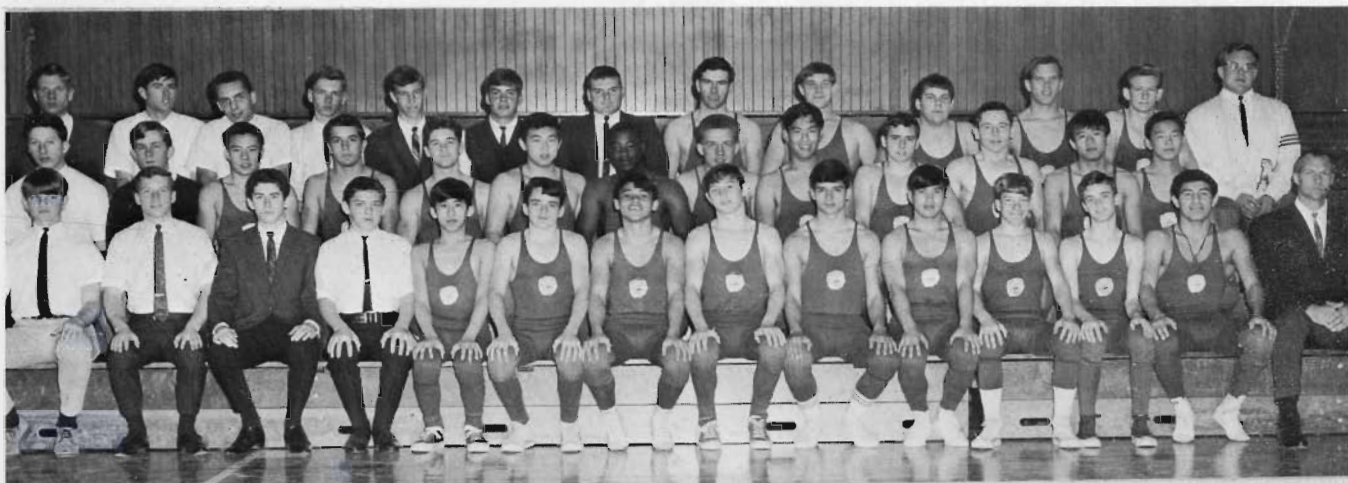

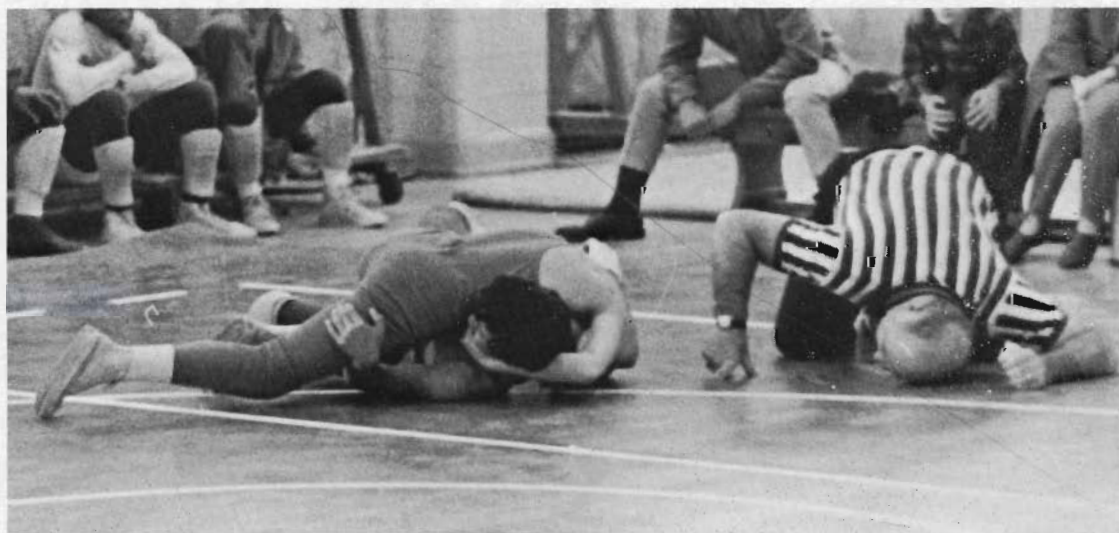
PROVING STRENGTH IN DEPTH

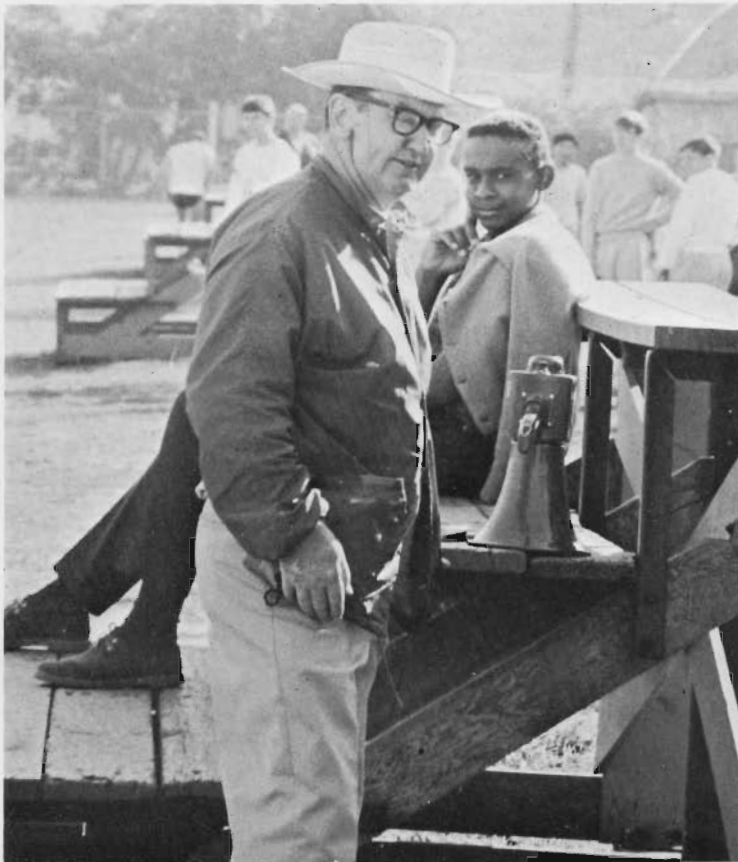
