History



In the past four years we have not established the history of Hillview School, so this year we bring it to you.

The land for Hillview School was originally part of the Sharon estate and was purchased from the Menlo Investment company, which managed this estate. We purchased nine and one-third acres. The price paid was forty-thousand dollars in 1949.

The building was completed in 1950 at the cost of \$108,029 and had six classrooms and a kindergarten. Four more classrooms were added later on in the year at the cost of \$71,986. The architect was Jassen and Daseking and the builder Howard J. White. The builder for the four additional classrooms in 1950 was Julian N. Basin.

We added a multi-purpose room, a kitchen, two craft-rooms and a second kindergarten in 1951. The cost came to \$265,509. This section of our school was built by Wells P. Goodenough.

In 1952 at the cost of \$148,372 Howard J. White added seven more classrooms, a music room and an addition to the administrative building, bringing the school up to its present size.

Our principals have been Glenn Smith, Homer Alderman, Paul Stouffer, Don Hurst and now John Martin.

Our enrollment has certainly increased since our opening in 1949 when it was only 175 pupils. Perhaps you would be interested in the exact figures, they are as follows: 1950-51 - 321; 1951-2 - 456; 1952-53 - 489; 1953-54 - 594; 1954-55 - 700. At the present time it looks as if next year's enrollment will be even higher.
