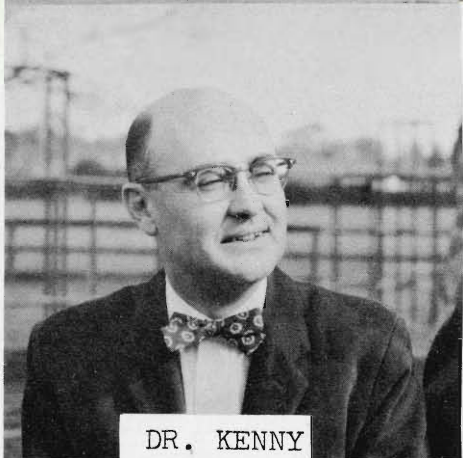
But let us not forget to mix with the knowledge of our brains some wisdom from our hearts--manners and morals should be as much a part of our lives as information and "Things."

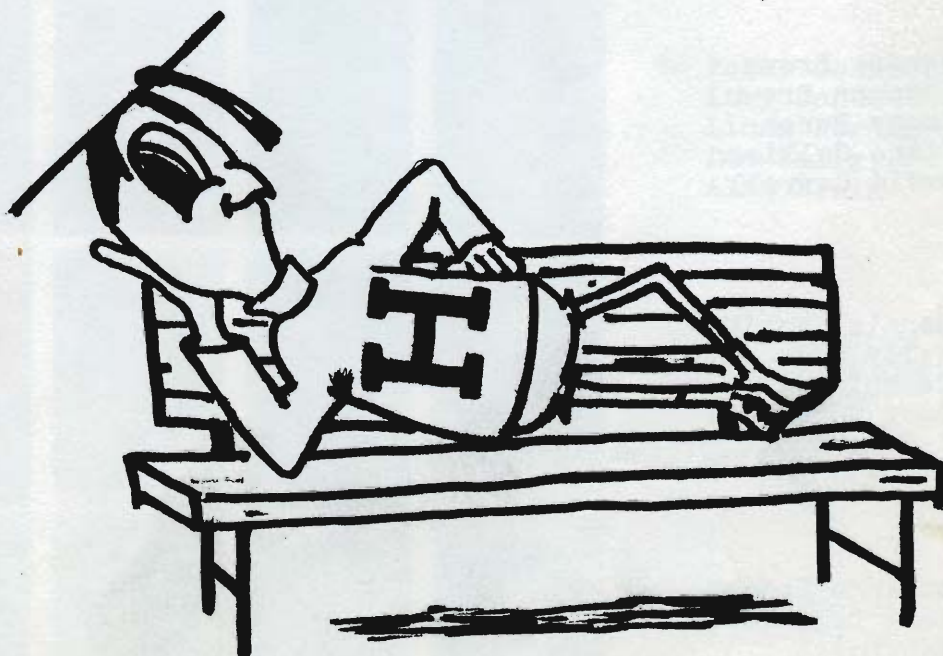
We, the class of 1961, Hillview School, Menlo Park, California, being of as sound a mind as possible, do hereby declare this our last will and testament.
