First: To Mr. Barnes and the entire teaching staff, we wish to extend our appreciation for their help and guidance through our first eight years of school.

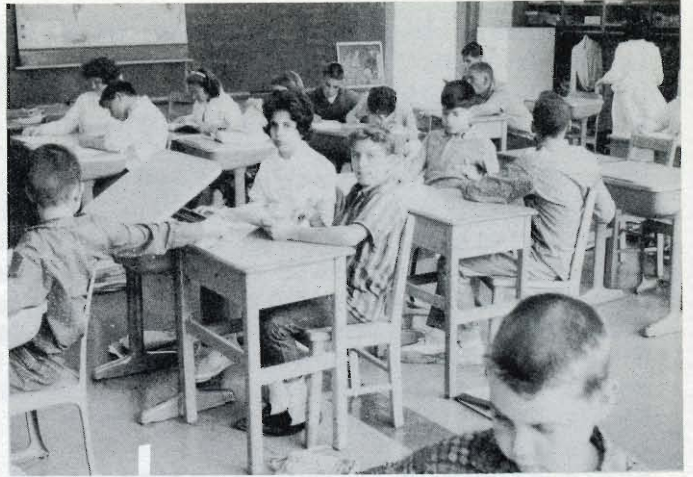

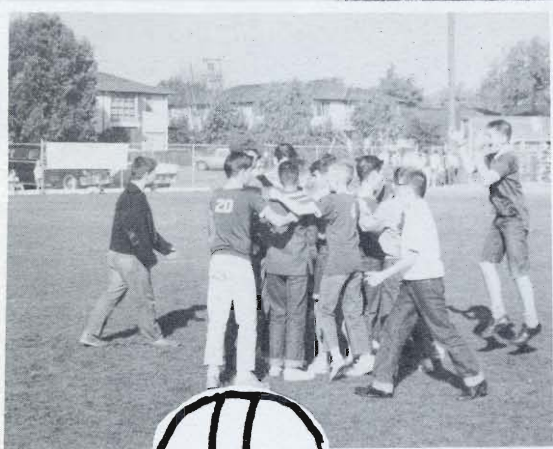
