Where greed carries a heavy weight,

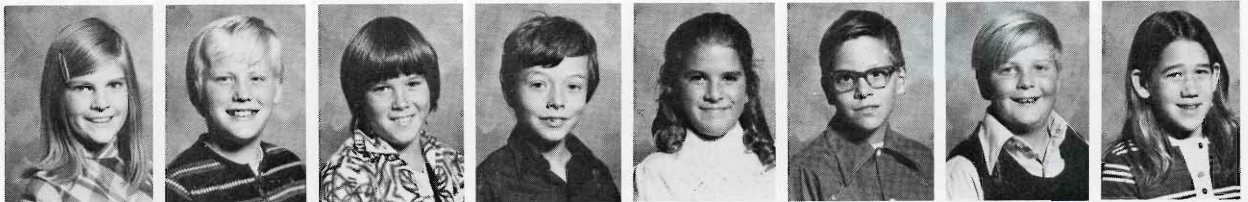

And treat all nature like a brother.

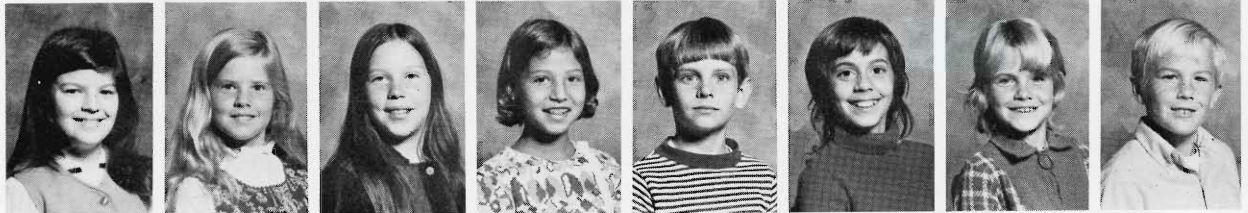
