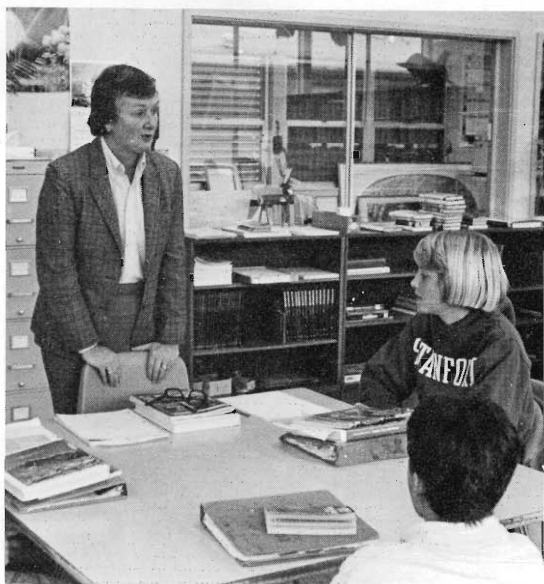

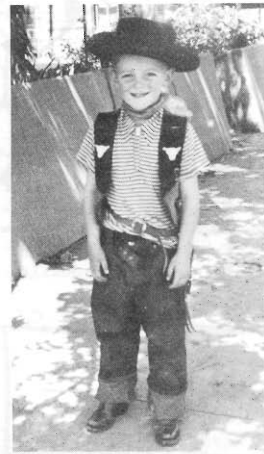




# Our Memory of Bob Robinson
