Hazel Bright, '13, has accepted a position as stenographer with the Standard Oil Company of Stockton.

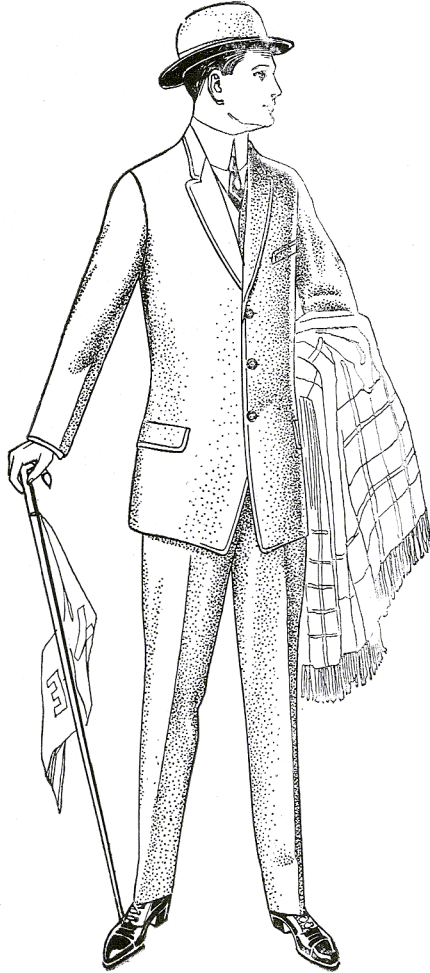
James Hammond is stenographer for the United States Tire Company in San Francisco.

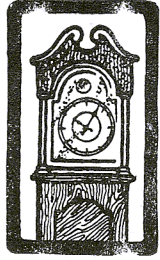

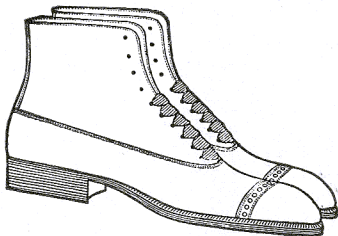
