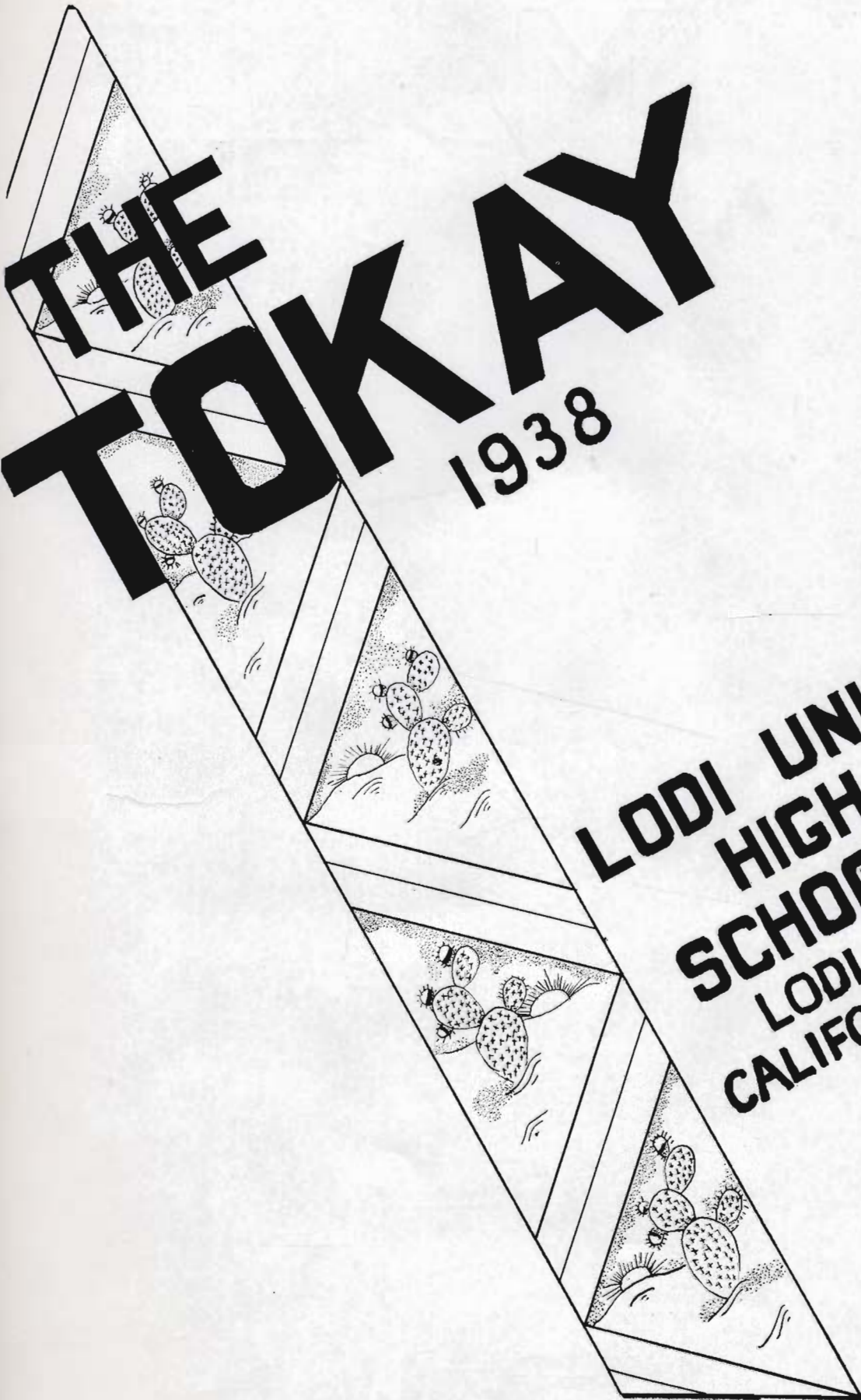

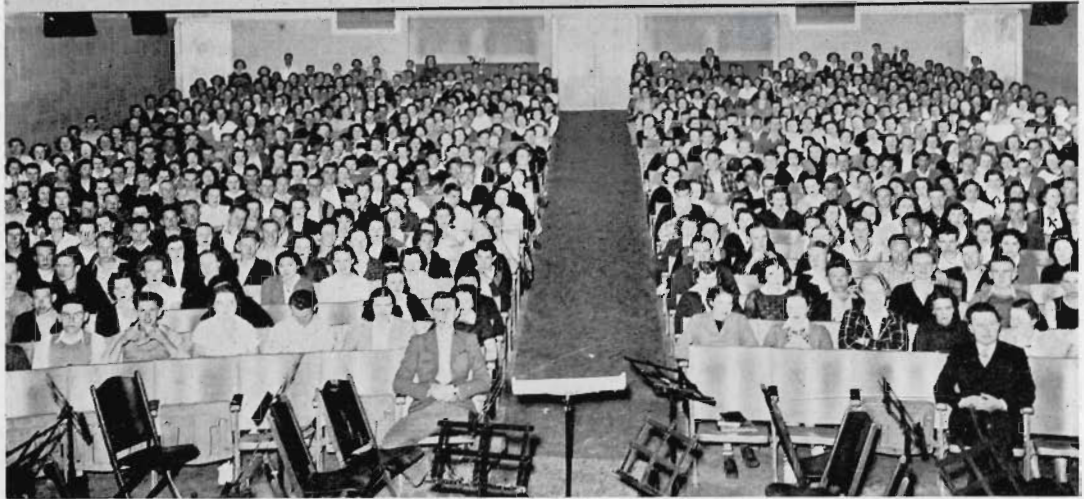

VAMOS A SER BUENOS AMIGOS

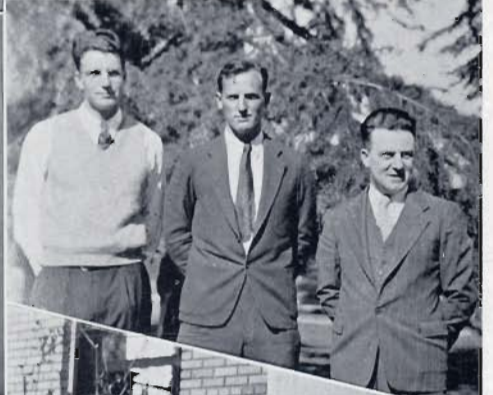
"Mexico" is the theme for the 1938 Tokay. The editorial staff in selecting this theme has made a splendid gesture of friendliness.
