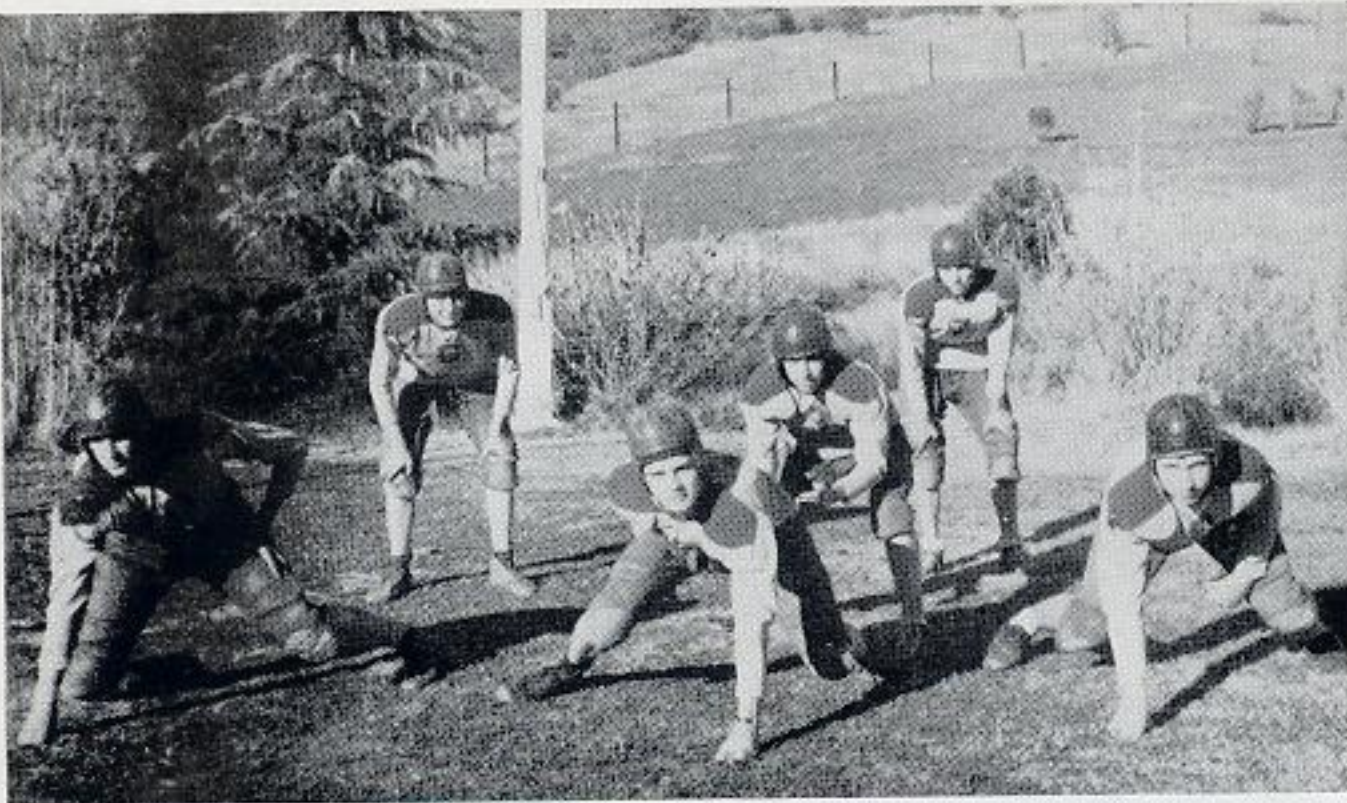

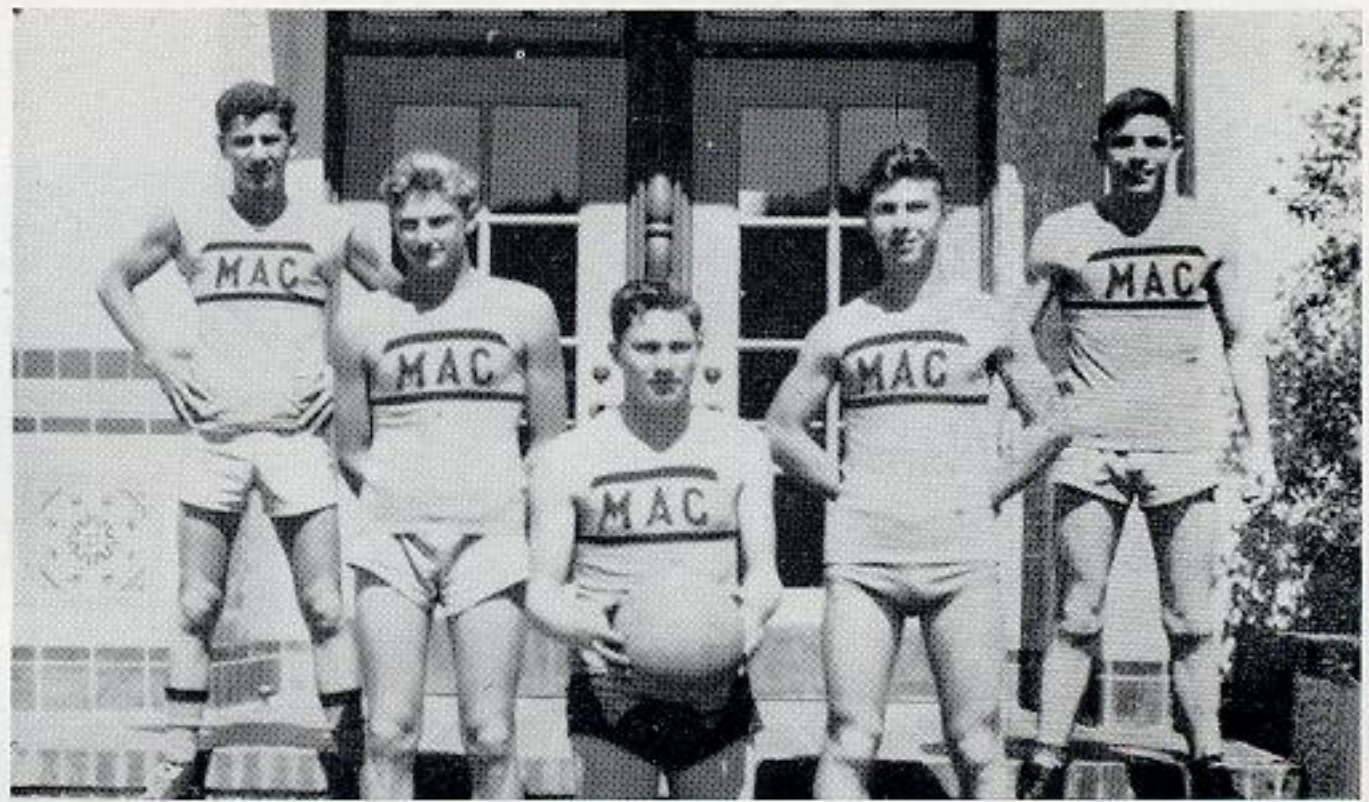

Sweaters were awarded to two Senior girls, Alberta Jeffery and Dorothy Dunn, for outstanding work in their four years participation.

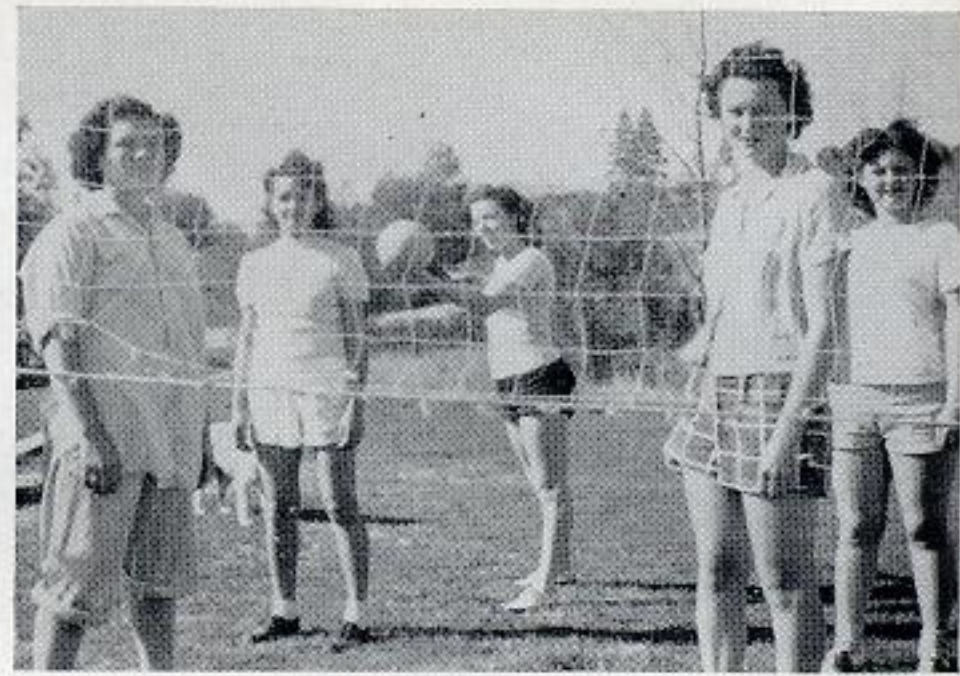
