The Stanislaus County Department of Public Health conducts a program which has the approval of the State Board of Public Health. In order to win such approval, a local health department must adequately perform six basic health functions as required by State Regulation. Those functions include:

1. Collection, tabulation and analysis of all public health statistics including records of communicable diseases, births and deaths.

2. A planned and organized health education program in the community.

3. Communicable disease control, including tuberculosis and venereal diseases. Such control includes provision of diagnostic and consultation services, investigation of disease epidemics and appropriate immunization procedures.

4. Services directed toward improvement of maternal and child health.

5. Services in sanitary practices throughout the County including sanitation of foods and water, rabies control and proper sewage disposal techniques.

6. Public health laboratory facilities available to all hospitals and physicians.

In carrying out these basic services, generally, the personnel in the Department perform duties and functions provided by law as established in:

1. The California Health and Safety Code.

2. The California Administrative Code—Title 17.

3. Local ordinances as established by the County Boards of Supervisors and City Councils within the jurisdiction.

In order to perform the necessary services adequately, the Department is divided into administrative divisions, each having its own functions. However, all divisions work closely together in order to provide the best possible service.

The Division of Public Health Nursing renders service on an individual, family, or community basis in the home, the school, public clinics, business establishments or the Department Office itself.

The responsibility of the Public Health Nurse are primarily in:

1. Maternal and Child Health, including school health.

2. Adult health Supervision and counseling.

3. Communicable diseases control.

4. Chronic disease supervision and counseling.

5. Crippled children's services.

The Division of Sanitation operates under the

philosophy that sanitation is a way of life. It is expressed in the clean home, the clean farm, the clean business and industry, the clean neighborhood and the clean community.

Each sanitarian has a district of the County in which he is responsible for raising the general health standards, which he promotes through health education. Those responsibilities include:

1. Proper sewage disposal techniques and provision of clean water for use of the people.

2. Proper food-handling practices in public places.

3. School sanitation.

4. Maintenance of sanitary swimming pools.

5. Investigation and eradication of public nuisance.

6. Promotion of industrial sanitation.

7. Insect and rodent control.

8. Rabies control.

The Public Health Laboratory provides services which are available to all doctors in the County, to aid in diagnosis and control of communicable diseases. It assists other laboratories in identification of disease germs. In accomplishing this function, the laboratory personnel have the training and equipment for reliable performance of a large variety of tests.

The Health Department's function in the field of vital statistics performs an important service for the residents of the County. Here are available, certified copies of Birth or Death Certificates. The former are used to establish proof of age, citizenship, eligibility for jobs, etc. The latter are necessary for settling estates, collecting on insurance policies etc.

Certificates of all births and deaths occurring in the County are sent to this office where they are checked for completeness and accuracy.

As part of its specialized services, the Department maintains and operates a mobile x-ray unit which visits various parts of the County routinely in an effort to find people who may be identified with tuberculosis. During a year, this unit x-rays the chests of approximately 20,000 people.

All the functions above-mentioned, are carried out by a small group of well qualified personnel. They are supported by the taxes paid by the people of Stanislaus County. Thus, the Department belongs to and serves the people. It is assisted in the work by interested citizens who volunteer their time and skills, serving in various ways.

Such volunteer helpers have proved to be particu-

larly useful in child health conferences and immunization programs. Without them, the operations of the Department would be reduced and a less effective operation would result.

The personnel of the Department feel that a public health agency is primarily an educational and public relations institution and its degree of progress is in direct proportion to its ability to educate people in proper public health practices and to its level of public relations. In this way only, can the highest general health and living standards of the residents of the County be attained.

Modesto City Hospital, located at the corner of 17th and H Streets in Modesto, California, was opened on September 1, 1950 with a 25-bed capacity.

In 1951, a new building, housing medical patients was added and this brought the capacity up to 35 beds. Making every effort to keep pace with a rapidly growing community, the hospital in 1954, opened a modern, Class A concrete type, three floor 'medical-surgical' addition of 50 beds. This new addition gave a total capacity of 85 beds and facilities for twelve newborn infants.

Modesto City Hospital is a general hospital, providing complete services for medical, surgical and maternity patients. The hospital maintains a completely equipped laboratory under the direction of a pathologist and has facilities for all routine examinations and many special tests. The laboratory also operates a blood bank for hospital use in conjunction with the Delta Blood Bank. The X-Ray Department, under the direction of a radiologist is equipped with all the necessary X-Ray units for diagnostic work. A recent addition to the X-Ray Department, was a powerful portable X-Ray Unit for work in the surgeries and emergency room.

The typical patient room is completely air-conditioned and is equipped with piped-in oxygen. There is a nurses' 'call system' (which enables the patient to talk directly with the nurses' station) and also a radio equipped with individual ear phones with station selector and volume control conveniently placed at the bedside.

Visitors are welcome between the hours of 2:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M. and also 7:00 to 8:00 P.M. No visitors under the age of 16 are permitted in the Maternity Department. However, children are welcome in the Medical and Surgical Departments during the evening visiting hours and on Sunday afternoon.

MEMORIAL HOSPITAL OF STANISLAUS COUNTY

Memorial Hospital, situated on Highway 99 South is a Non-profit Hospital Association. It was built by and for the citizens of Stanislaus County and has passed its sixth year of operation. Since its establishment, it has grown to offer patients every facility necessary for the care and treatment of the

general type of illnesses affecting our community.

In the year just past, Memorial Hospital has installed a complete new diagnostic X-Ray Unit. We now have two units available. A complete new cystoscopic X-Ray Unit has been added also, for the detection and treatment of urinary disorders. The finest in operating room lights was recently installed for the benefit of the many surgeons on the staff at Memorial. These are but a few of the major attempts on the part of Memorial Hospital to provide the utmost in modern hospital care. Many minor additions are continually being made to augment all of the hospital services.

Soon, Memorial Hospital will demonstrate its ability to keep abreast of the public's needs for more hospital beds. Having operated at 85 percent of capacity for the past year, the opening of Unit 2 (a facility for convalescents and senior citizens) has alleviated occasional bed shortages that have required turning patients away.

The new unit now houses 50 beds in 26 large, comfortably air-conditioned and beautifully furnished rooms.

Then, the original hospital of 93 beds will have grown to the large size of 143 beds. Memorial Hospital is growing with a growing community.

MODESTO STATE HOSPITAL

The Modesto State Hospital is one of thirteen hospitals administered under the California State Department of Mental Hygiene in Sacramento. It is located two miles northwest of the City of Modesto on US Highway 99. The entrance is approximately a half mile from the highway.

There are approximately 3,300 patients regularly in the hospital, which has a staff including almost 1,000 employees.

Extensive medical and psychiatric evaluations are made of each patient in order to achieve the hospital goals to give the best and most effective care and treatment to the patients to assist them in their recovery and return to their normal life.

Visiting (after the first 10 days following admission) is permitted relatives, and the patient may be visited by friends when written permission from the patient's relatives or guardian is obtained. When recovery is such that the ward doctor feels visits are beneficial and the patient wishes to see them, such permission is not necessary. Visiting hours are from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. and from 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. daily. Hospital Superintendent and Medical Director is W. M. O'Brien, M.D.

STANISLAUS COUNTY HOSPITAL

Stanislaus County Hospital, established in 1856, is located at 830 Scenic Drive, Modesto. Telephone is LA 4-1251.

It is a 400-bed capacity hospital, and is equipped not only with general hospital facilities; but has special equipment for the care of Polio patients,

and also tuberculosis patients. Visiting hours are as follows:

CHILDREN'S WARD

2:30 to 3:30 P.M., Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday only.

TUBERCULOSIS WARD

2:30 to 3:30 P.M., Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday; 7:00 to 8:00 P.M., Tuesdays, Thursday and Sunday. No visiting on Mondays and Fridays.

MEDICAL, SURGICAL, CHRONIC, ISOLATION and POLIO WARDS

2:30 to 3:30 P.M. and 7:00 to 8:00 P.M. daily. No children under 16 are allowed to visit.

OAKDALE MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL

Oakdale Municipal Hospital is located at 700 Laurel Street, Oakdale. It is a general hospital having bed capacity for 32 patients.

Visiting hours are from 2:00 to 4:00 P.M. and from 7:00 to 8:00 P.M. daily.

Hospital Administrator is Ralph B. Thole.

LILLIAN COLLINS HOSPITAL, Turlock

Lillian Collins Hospital, located at Crane and Thor Streets in Turlock, was founded in 1925, and is owned by Marion C. Collins, M.D., F.A.C.S., F.I.C.S.

General hospital facilities are available; bed capacity is 40.

Visiting hours from 2:00 to 4:00 P.M. and from 7:00 to 8:30 P.M.

Maternity Ward visiting hours are from 2:30 to 4:00 P.M. and from 7:00 to 8:30 P.M.

Hospital Administrator is John W. Kludt.

EMANUEL HOSPITAL, Turlock

The Emanuel Hospital of Turlock was founded in 1917. It is owned and operated by the Evangelical Mission Covenant Association of California, a non-profit corporation. It offers general hospital facilities, and has a 50-bed capacity.

Visiting hours are from 2:00 to 4:00 P.M. and 7:00 to 9:00 P.M. No children under 16 are permitted to visit.

DEL PUERTO HOSPITAL, Patterson

Del Puerto Hospital, 9th Street, Patterson, California, was established in 1950. It has a bed capacity of 25 and offers general hospital facilities.

Visiting hours are from 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. and from 6:30 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Maternity Ward visiting hours from 3:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. and from 7:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.

Hospital Administrator is Miss Dorothy Kaehler, R.N.

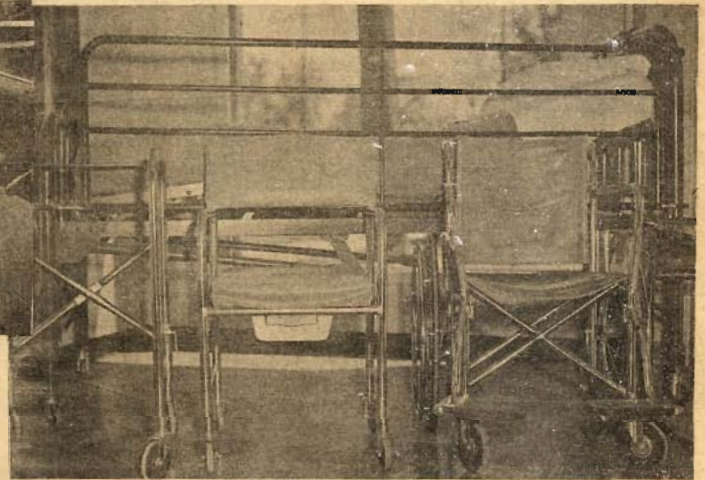

BOY SCOUTS OF STANISLAUS COUNTY

The Yosemite Area Council, Inc., of Boy Scouts of America includes the four counties of Tuolumne, Stanislaus, Merced and Mariposa. It has its headquarters in the City of Modesto. Within the County, the Scout Movement enjoys the whole-hearted support of every community therein, for about 60 percent of the 7,603 Council members come from Stanislaus County.

The Boy Scouts offer three distinct programs for boys between the ages of 8 and 18: Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting and Explorer Scouting; each one filled with adventure, learning and fun.

Cubbing: A Home-centered program of boy-action, which includes a plan of advancement, through which boys learn by doing. It has been developed especially for parents of the 8 to 10 year olds, to use with and for their sons.

Boy Scouting: The program for boys 11 to 14 years old. This program offers the chance to hike, camp, be in the out-of-doors, and belong to a "patrol" that works together and learns many skills and techniques. Some of the skills offered are: first aid, knot tying, compass and map reading, fire building, cooking, signalling, etc. The motto is "BE PREPARED" and from the first day a boy becomes a Scout, he begins preparing himself to help other people.

The *Explorer* Program, is for all young men fourteen years of age or older, regardless of whether or not they have been Boy Scouts. While a registered Scout automatically becomes an Explorer on his fourteenth birthday, any young man of that age, may become an *Explorer* by joining a Boy Scout Troop in his neighborhood; an Explorer Post of a Sea Explorer Ship. He must be willing to take upon himself the *Explorer Citizenship Pledge*.

GIRL SCOUTS OF STANISLAUS COUNTY

A Girl Scout can be any girl that is in any grade of school from the second grade in elementary school until she graduates from High School. An Adult Girl Scout is the woman or man that serves as a leader, troop committee members, board of directors, or professional staff members. Many girls continue their scouting activities through college and after they are out of school as Adult Girl Scouts. There are quite a few men that help with the Girl Scouts in a number of ways, some help only when they are needed; like the ones that drive the buses for

Day Camp. Some are serving on the official board of directors all through the year.

The Girl Scout organization in Stanislaus County is known as the Stanislaus Council of Girl Scouts. There were many troops and some councils in various county towns, that joined together in July of 1951 to form the one council. A better program for the girls at less cost is possible with the unified council.

Troops now in the Stanislaus Council are located in Modesto, Newman, Patterson, Westley, Vernalis, Ceres, Hughson, Riverbank, Graton, Keyes, Turlock, and Denair. The Council is supported by the Turlock Fund Drive, the United Crusade in Modesto, and the Community Chest in other participating towns.

Girl Scouts are divided into age groups of Brownies: second, third and fourth grades; Intermediate Scouts: fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth grades, and the Senior Girl Scouts of High School age.

Brownies' service projects are making favors and special occasion decorations for the patients at the State Hospital.

Intermediate Scouts have a wider scope of service to others. They have planned and given parties for the State Hospital, sung Christmas Carols for shut-ins, collected and sent clothing for Indian relief, and provided parties for the children in the local receiving home.

The Senior Scouts take part in most of these projects and also have a program of training to prepare them for helping beyond what the younger scouts can do. This training serves as a vocational guide to the Seniors, by giving them actual practice in many fields of work. So far, the girls have trained and are serving as Hospital Aides and Program Aides. The Program Aides have been trained in teaching and leading songs and games and other activities, so they can help with the Intermediate and Brownie troops. The Hospital Aides are trained and are serving under the regular hospital staff as their helpers. The girls will have more training programs when they want and have the opportunity to use them. There are also Senior Girl Scouts working on a disaster relief project in cooperation with the Boy Scouts.

If a girl wants to join a troop and does not know of one, she should ask the principal of her school for the name of the Neighborhood Chairman. The Neighborhood Chairman can tell the girl where there is a troop that she can join and when the troop meets.

The Stanislaus Council of Girl Scouts hopes to increase the number of girls having the advantage of Scout experiences and to provide a better program to make these experiences even more of an advantage for the girls.

THE UNIVERSITY'S SERVICE TO HOMEMAKERS

What kind of service is Agricultural Extension? Who can participate? How does it work? These are all questions commonly asked.

The University of California school of agriculture has for its extended service to taxpayers, a campus in each county willing to support it. This is the Agricultural Extension Service designed to bring the latest information in the field of agriculture and home economics to people of the county. In home economics, the home advisors, Mrs. Dorothy Schreiner and Miss Madelyn Williams, bring information to adult homemakers. Miss Mary Regan is in charge of girls' 4-H Club work in the county. Salaries of the Extension Service staff are paid by the University of California, the cost of doing the work in the county is paid by county funds.

The work is tax supported and all people are free to use this service in the way it best suits their need.

Groups of women in 18 different locations in the county, e.g.; Ceres, Empire, Denair, East and West Turlock, Oakdale, etc., are organized to make known their needs and interests in Home Economics subject matter. From these requests a program of meetings is made up. In the fall of 1958 our program of meetings will include:

Planning an Herb Garden
Furniture refinishing (wood finishes)
New textiles and their care
Planning a color co-ordinated wardrobe
Sewing short cuts
Herbs in Economy Meals

The home advisor makes personal visits to help homemakers with their remodeling and new home plans. She can be a big help in room arrangement, storage plans, selecting and co-ordinating color throughout the house and helping in the selection of drapery and upholstery fabrics.

The home advisors have helped over 800 families in consultation at the office, over the phone, or in the home on special nutrition problems designed to control weight, high protein diets.

Through the summer months our biggest program concerns food preservation, e.g., how to freeze fruits and vegetables in season, safe methods of canning, pickling and drying foods. Circulars are available free and for the asking on these subjects.

CIVIL DEFENSE

The Board of Supervisors of Stanislaus County, realizing its responsibility to the citizens within its jurisdiction against the possibility of either a natural disaster or a man-made disaster, passed County Ordinance No. 305 establishing a Stanislaus County Disaster Council, and on May 12, 1952, by a resolution, designated Stanislaus County as a Civil Defense Operational Area. The Ordinance, together with Federal and State Statutes, provides for the organization and operation of all the resources of the County in case the normal agencies are unable to cope with a given situation.

Disaster Council membership is presently composed of Robert Adams, Chairman; E. W. Hane, Executive Officer; and Thomas Bright, Coordinator, plus the heads of the various service departments who are, for the most part, department heads presently in County employment.

It is the present policy of the Stanislaus County Disaster Council to maintain an adequate cadre for the protection of the populace under its jurisdiction. This cadre is composed chiefly of government-

al employees supplemented with technically-trained volunteers. Three components of the Council are solely volunteer personnel, such as, the Ground Observer Corps, the Radiological Monitoring Squad, and the Radio Amateur Group. The office of Coordinator of Civil Defense for Stanislaus County is maintained in Room 205, County Offices Building, Modesto, California. It has the responsibility of coordinating the various departments of County government during times of disaster and also has the responsibility of coordinating the training and planning for the various types of disaster which might be received in Stanislaus County. REGISTRATION AND ELECTION INFORMATION

Simple Qualification to Register as a Voter:

1. Be a Citizen of the United States.
2. Be 21 years of age by Election Day.
3. Be a resident of: (a) The State one year prior to Election Day; (b) The County 90 days prior to Election Day; (c) The Precinct 54 days prior to Election Day.
4. Be able to read the English Language and write (his or her) name.

Closing Date for Voters to Register:

A qualified person may register at any time, but should the voter register after the 54 day close of registration period, he would be precluded from voting in that designated election.

The closing date for voters to register is 54 days prior to any election, but should it be a special election, registration would be closed only to the special district or municipality.

Who Must Register: California has permanent registration, therefore, you have to register only if you:

1. Have not registered in California before.
2. Failed to vote in either the last Primary or General Election.
3. Have moved since you registered.
4. Have changed your name since you registered.

If You Have Moved: If you have moved into Stanislaus County within 90 days of the election but have a valid registration in another California county, you may vote in your own county precinct either by going to your old precinct on election day or by absentee ballot.

Absentee Registration: If for geographical reasons you are unable to register in the normal manner, you are otherwise eligible to do so, you can register in absence. Obtain the required affidavit of registration in duplicate from the County Clerk, Modesto, appear before a Notary, fill out the affidavit and send it to the County Clerk before registration closes.

Absentee Voting: If you have moved into a different precinct in Stanislaus County within 54 days of the election but have a valid registration in your old precinct you may vote in your old precinct on election day, or request an absentee ballot.

If for geographical or physical reasons you expect to be unable to go to your polling place on election day, you may:

1. Apply in person or writing to the body conducting the election for an absentee voter's ballot. If applying by mail, sign the application, give your place of residence, the address

to which you wish the ballot to be mailed and reason for your request.

2. Apply not more than 20 days nor less than five days before election day, unless confined to hospital within five days of election, then request for absentee ballot must be accompanied by a medical statement.
3. Mark your ballot any day before the election at the office of the body conducting the election, or mark your ballot, seal it in identification envelope, sign the identification envelope and return to the body conducting the election; the ballot must be received not more than 16 days after the election and must be post-marked not later than the day of election.

The County, State and National Elections are conducted by the County Clerk, City Election by the City Clerk, District Elections by the Governing Board of the district.

How Do You Register: You may register for any election at any time except within 54 days preceding that election. You register by filing an affidavit of registration in the office of L. W. Bither, County Clerk, County Court House in Modesto, or with a Deputy Registrar of Voters, located throughout Stanislaus County which have been appointed by L. W. Bither for the convenience of voters.

OFFICES OF THE COUNTY CLERK

The office of the County Clerk is also the depository of public records, which includes filing of civil probate, criminal and juvenile actions under the jurisdiction of the three departments of the Superior Court of our County. Also, the filing of corporation certificates, certificates of partnership and fictitious names, official bonds, notary public procedures, statements of attorney in fact and bonding companies, are filed in this office.

The main office of the County Clerk also issues certain licenses provided by State and County Ordinances, which include marriage licenses, carnival licenses, garbage licenses, and dog licenses.

The County Clerk is also ex-officio supervising clerk of the following departments: Clerk of the Superior Court, Naturalization Clerk, Passport Agent, Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Secretary of the Boundary Commission, and Jury Commissioner.

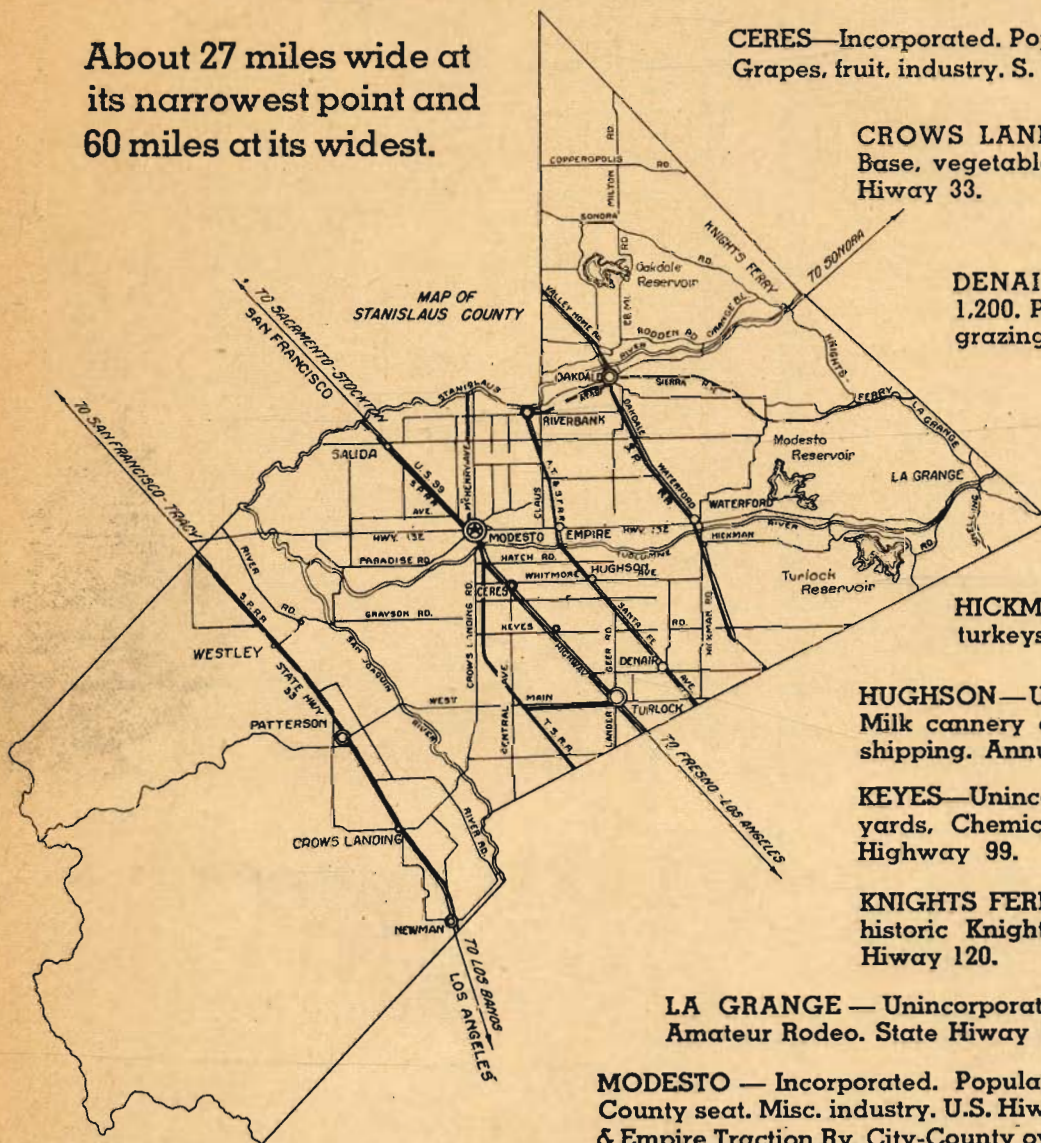
