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INTRODUCTION

Four Major Departments

The four major departments are arranged in the following order: --

I. THE BUYERS' GUIDE constitutes the first major department of the Directory, printed on yellow paper. In the first section of this department, grouped under appropriate headings, are included the advertisements and business cards of firms and individuals desiring to make a complete presentation of their products or services. Following this is the Classified Business section, which embraces a list of the names and addresses of all business and professional concerns of the community, arranged in alphabetical order under appropriate headings—a catalog of all the activities of the community. The Buyers' Guide represents reference advertising at its best, and merits the attention of all buyers and sellers seeking sources of supply or markets for goods. In a busy and diversified community like Menlo Park, the necessity of having this kind of information up-to-date and always immediately available, is obvious. In this section the named streets in alphabetical order; the residences and business houses are arranged numeri-

The names of the intersecting streets appear at their respective crossing points on each street. Special features of this section are the designation of owner occupied homes. Telephone numbers as supplied to us on canvass are shown opposite the name. ZIP Codes are also included.

IV. THE NUMERICAL TELEPHONE DIRECTORY for Menlo Park is the fourth major department, printed on blue paper.

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MENLO PARK

Menlo Park is a friendly residential community of essentially rural character and charm. Large yards and informal gardens are the rule, the relatively high minimum size of homesites having been carefully preserved through strict attention to good zoning practices.

The city's growing commercial district serves a trading area with a population of more than 60,000, including a major portion of the town of Atherton which is the state's second richest city per capita. Ample

off-street parking has made parking meters unnecessary.

The city's "garden office building" areas now include Lane Publishing Co. (Sunset Magazine), Allstate Insurance Co., A. C. Nielsen Co., U. S. 
