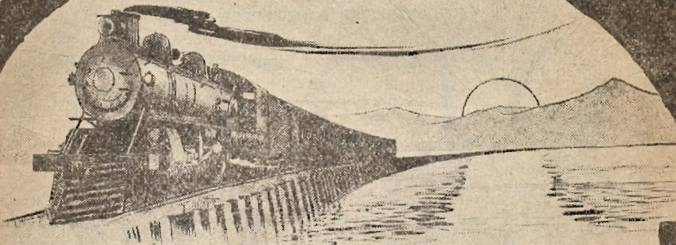

INTRODUCTORY

The extraordinary difficulties which have been encountered in making the Sacramento directory during the past two years will now be greatly mitigated and hereafter the labor and expense formerly spent by the warring factions will be devoted to the accuracy and completeness of the Sacramento directory, and a considerable improvement may be expected.
