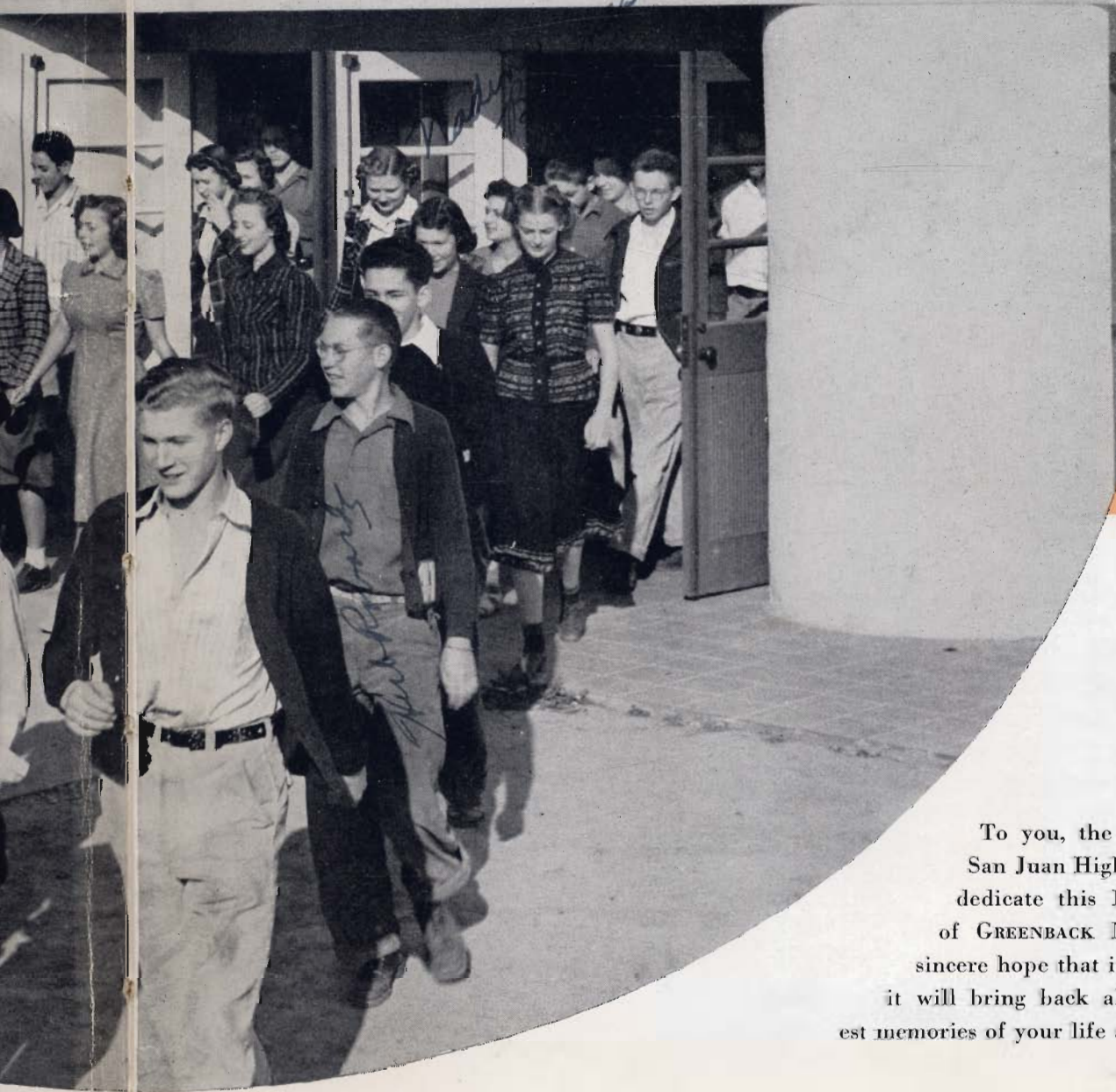
Foreword
