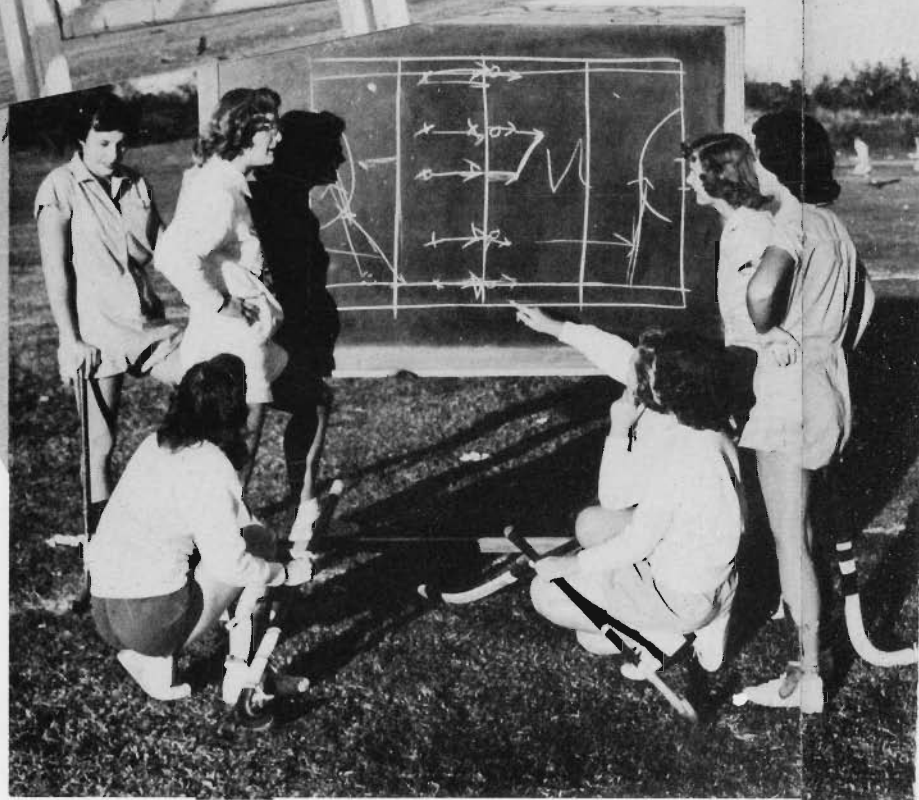

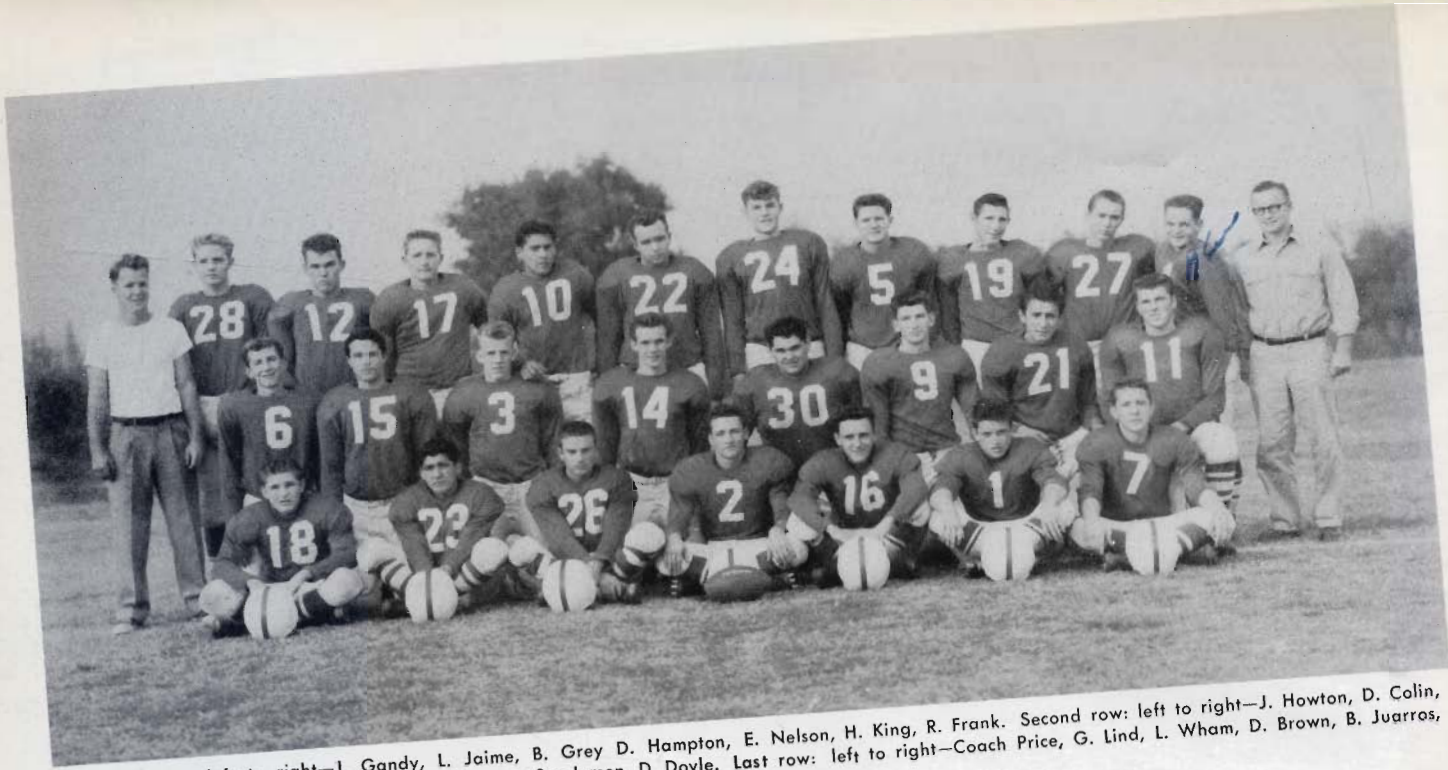

The team had many outstanding players with Bob Juarros being picked as Chronicle prep star and Gary Lind as all conference tackle.







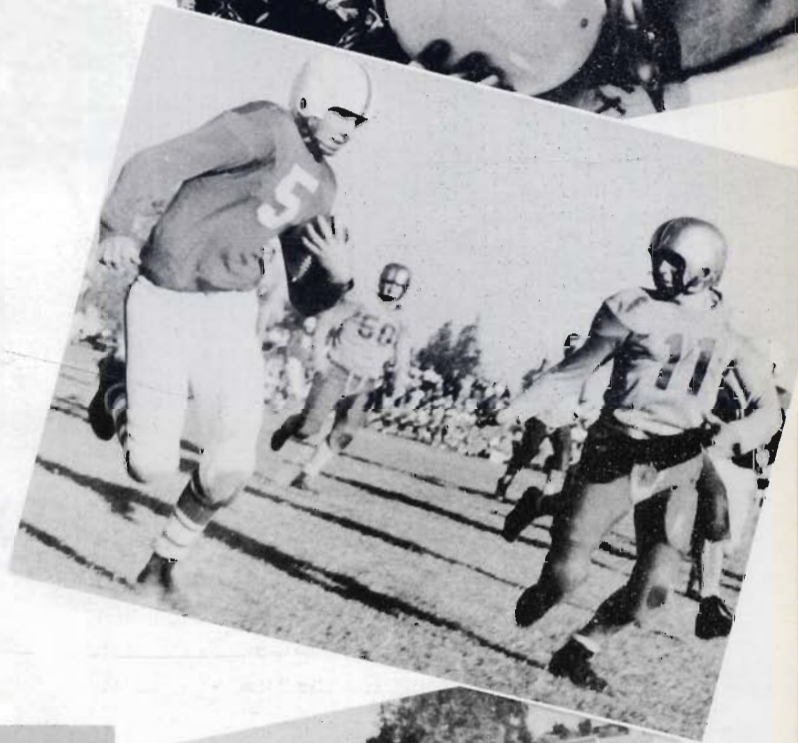

Coach Doudnik is to be commended for having a top team in his first year as coach at San Juan.



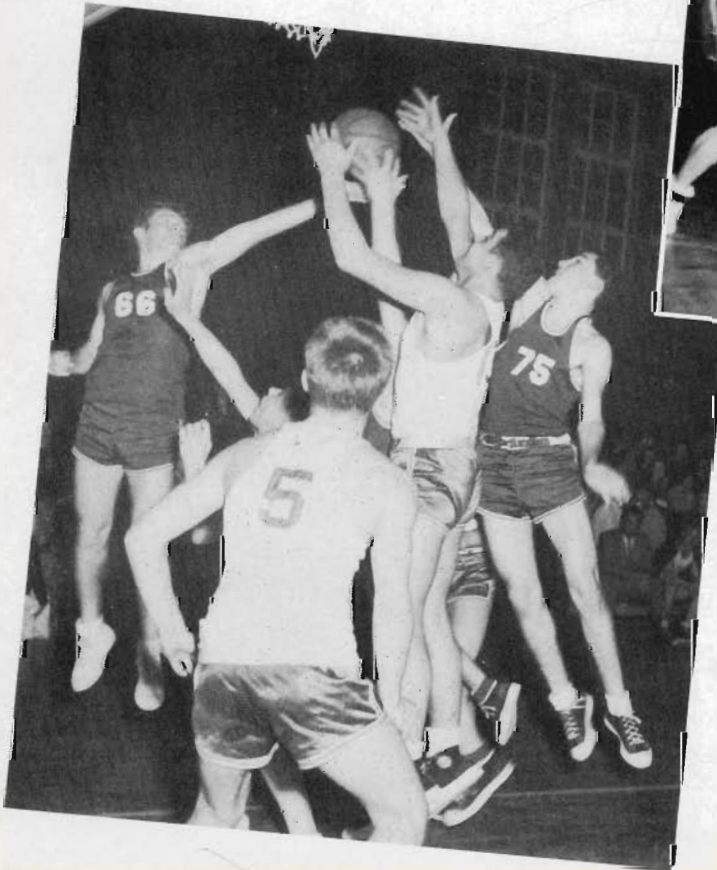
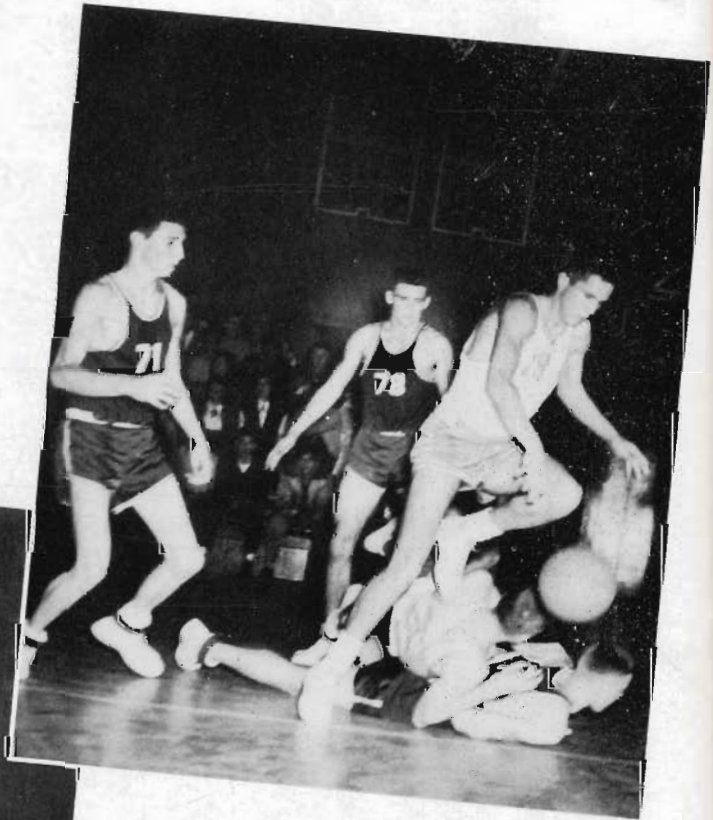

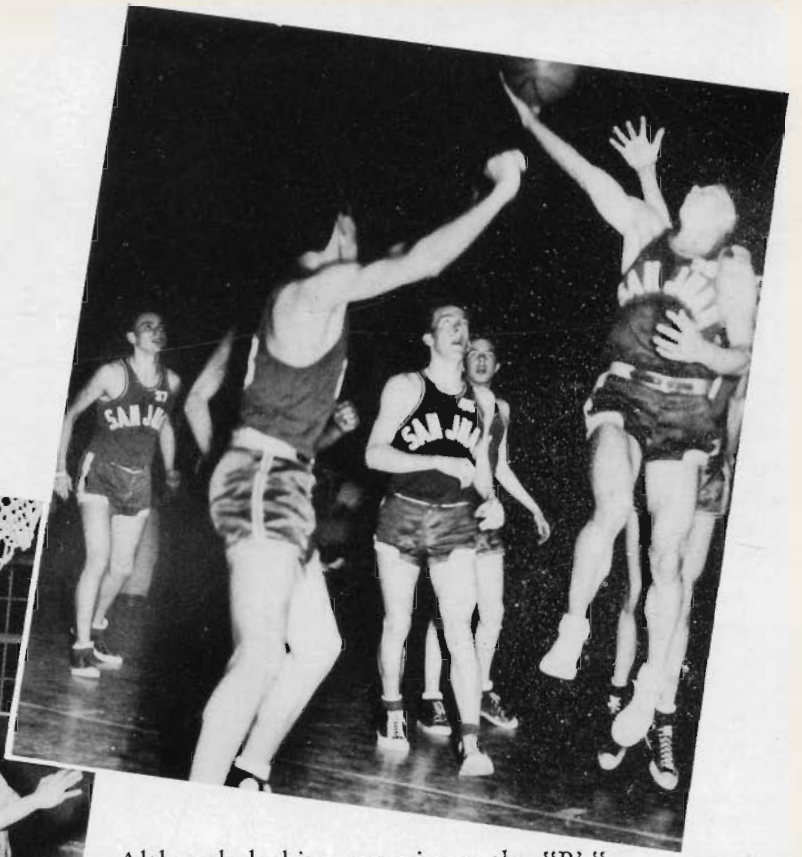

# "B" Team



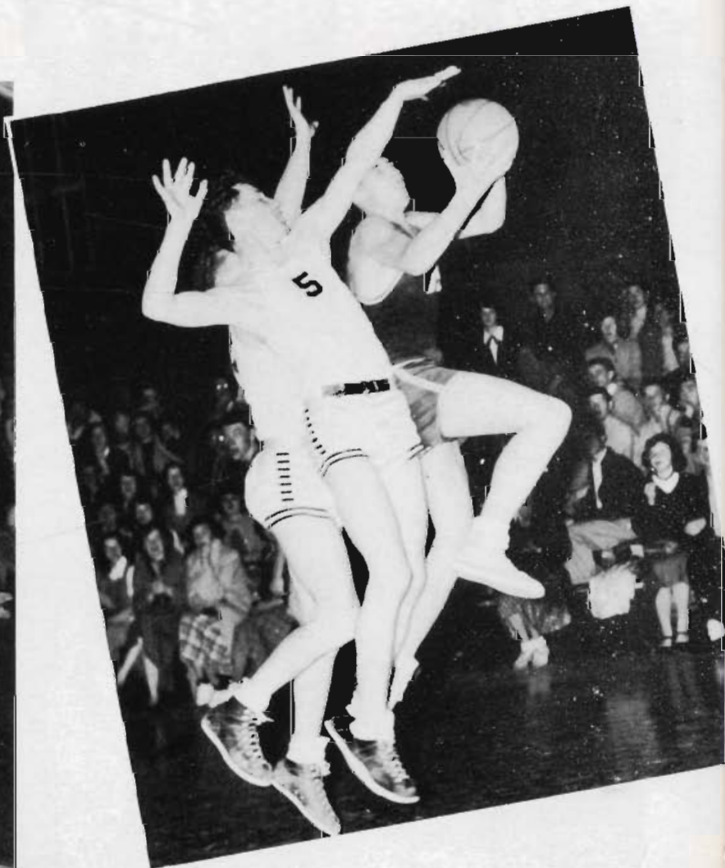
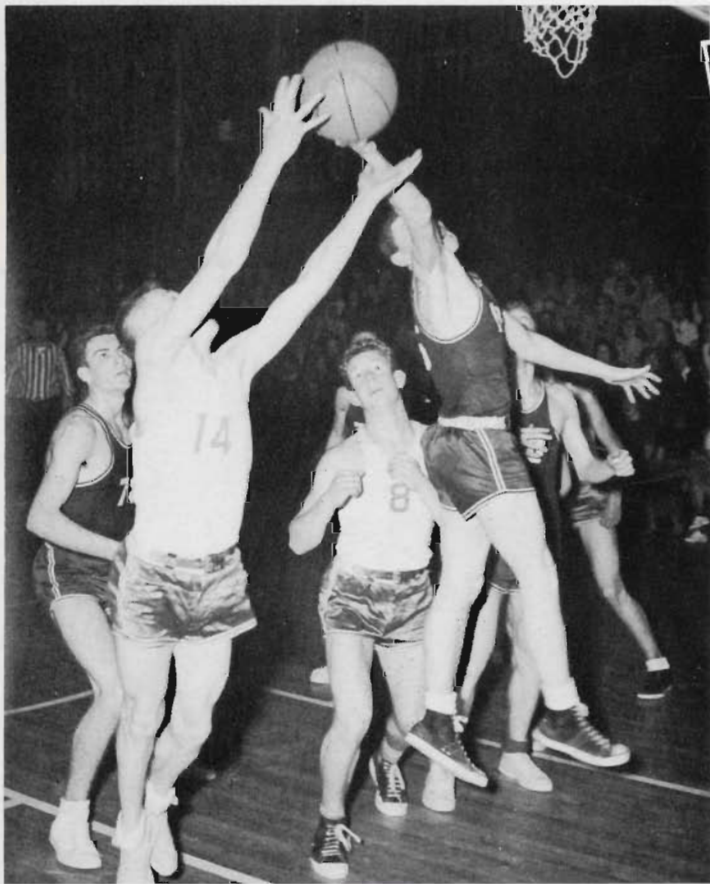
Although lacking experience the "B's" wound up in fifth place this year. However the boys' ability should not be judged only on their standing in the league as many of the games were lost by merely one point.

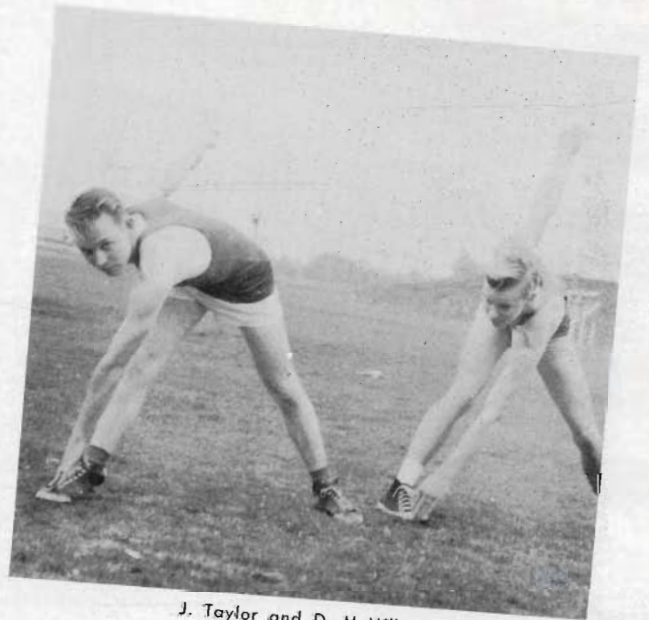

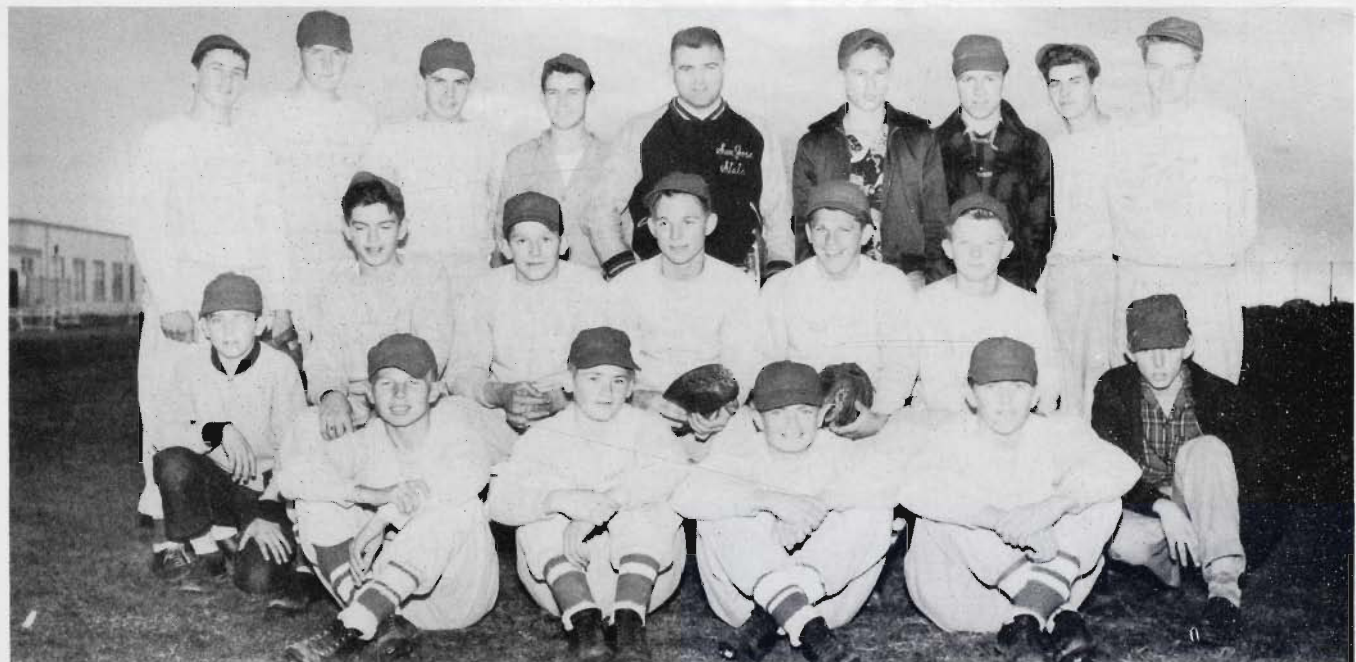
