

SENIOR CLASS HISTORY

Then we successfully produced our junior play, "June Mad," a comedy about a young teenage girl growing up. Richard Maloof played for our dreamy junior prom, "Moonlight Mist." We bid farewell to the graduating seniors with the annual Junior-Senior Banquet, which we built around the fitting theme of "Sayonara."

When we entered the world of senior year, it was hard to realize that we had come this far. We wanted more rights, privileges, and recognition which we could only gain by showing we deserved them. We were wise in our choice of class officers as we elected, Larry Rhodes, president; Bob Blechschmidt, vice-president; Linda Geiler, secretary; and Carole Wolff, treasurer. We put over an outstanding drama for our senior play, called "Outward Bound." This year we leaned back and relaxed at the Junior-Senior Banquet and reminiscingly danced at the Senior Ball, thinking back through the crazy things we'd done, the games and rallies we'd attended, the songs we hummed, the kids we met, and the teachers and counselors we'd known. Up the ladder of memorable events we've climbed and as graduation falls upon us, as we sing the Alma Mater for the last time, we enthusiastically advance into a new world as young adults.
