SECTION 28, COPYRIGHT LAW, IN FORCE

JULY 1st, 1909.

“That any person who willfully and for profit shall infringe any copyright secured by this Act, or who shall knowingly and willfully aid or abet such infringement, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment for not exceeding one year, or by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars, nor more than one thousand dollars, or both in the discretion of the court.”

POPULATION.

If the growth of a city is steady, showing a gradual increase from year to year, that community can be put down as a prosperous one, no boom to inflate the population one year and a corresponding decrease the following year.

The Directory of Stockton for 1907 contained 13,039 names, the 1908 edition had 13,351, while the issue for 1909 has 13,871—an increase of 520 names since the 1908 issue. Using the usual multiple of $2\frac{1}{2}$ to represent the women and children who are not included in the canvass, shows the population of Stockton today to be 34,677.

The publishers take pleasure in returning thanks for the courtesy extended to their representatives and for the liberal patronage extended to this publication and assure their patrons that every effort will be put forth to make each succeeding issue superior to its predecessor.
