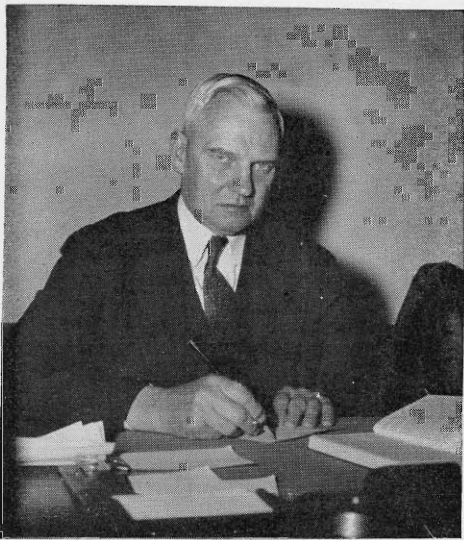

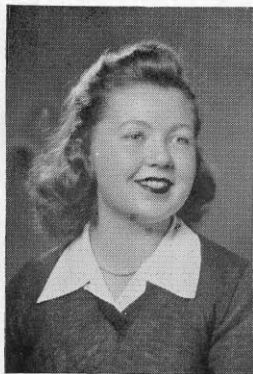

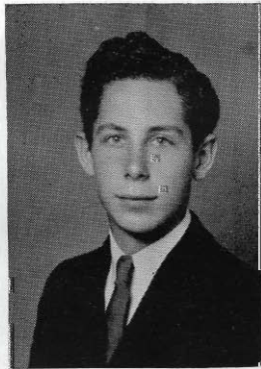

Miss Comings is the guiding light of the girls' division of the student body, the A. G. S. She aptly directs all of their social service activities and functions.

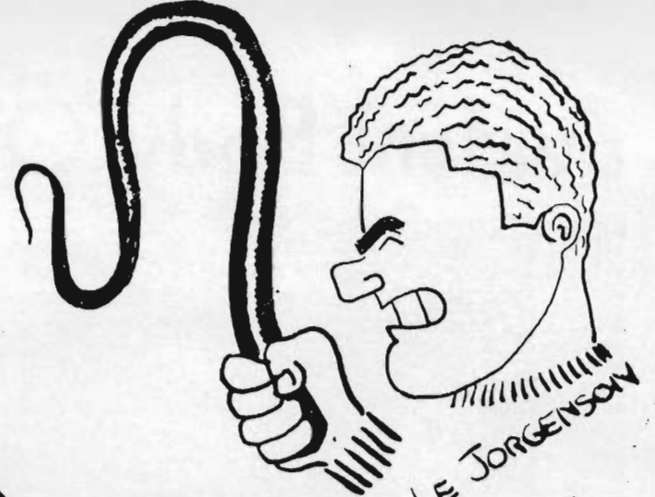

ALTHOUGH the Bearcat footballers failed to set the league on fire last season with any razzle-dazzle trickery, they nevertheless had the distinction of being, statistically at least, the best group of turf wrestlers to wear the Orange and Black colors since the famous team of '36.
