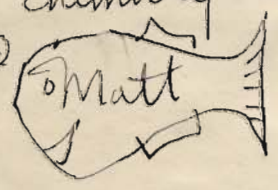

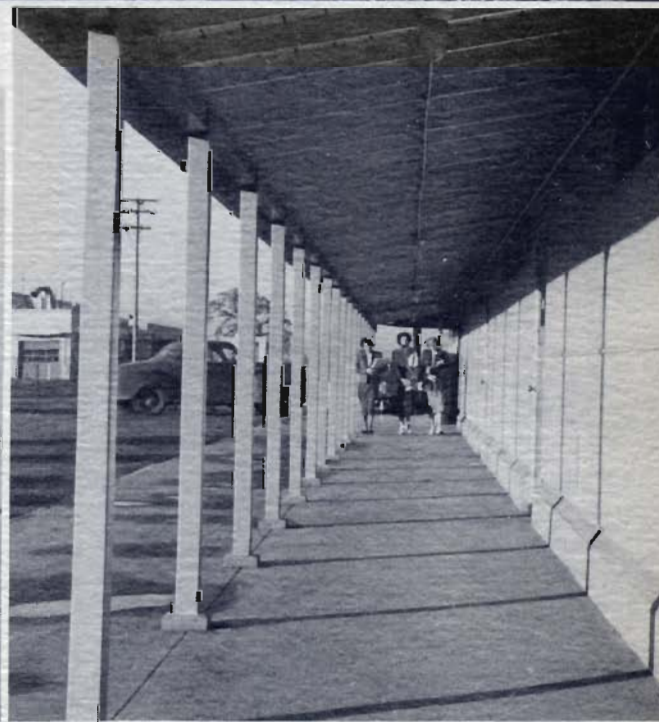

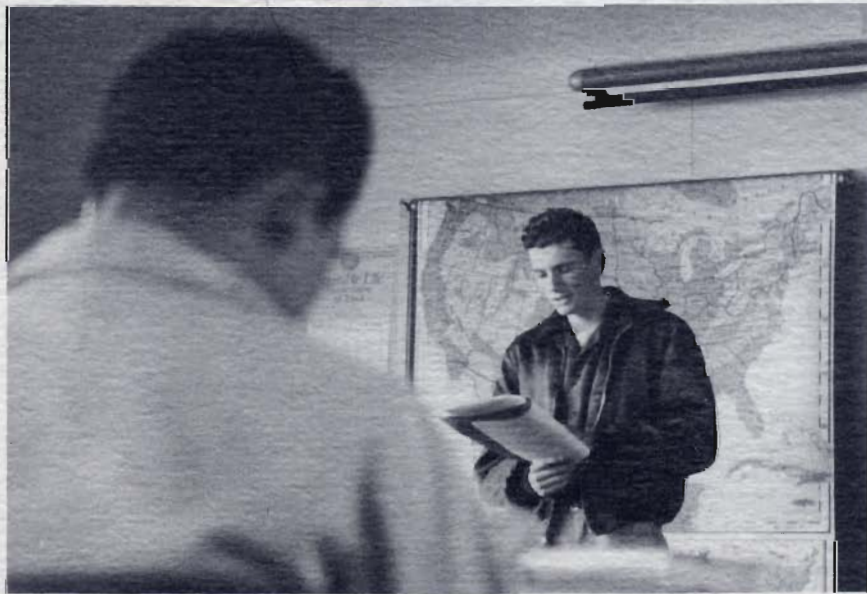
Our School
