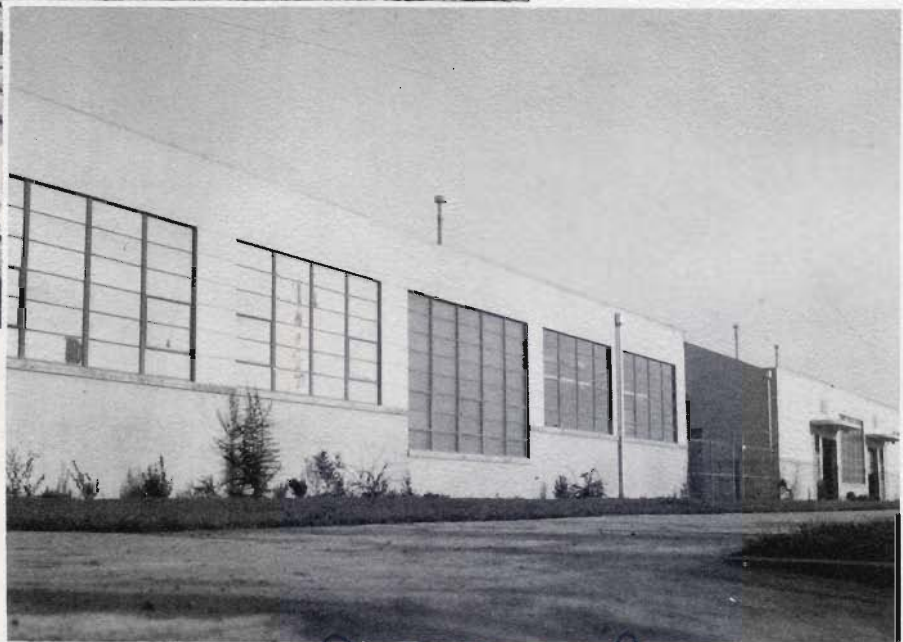




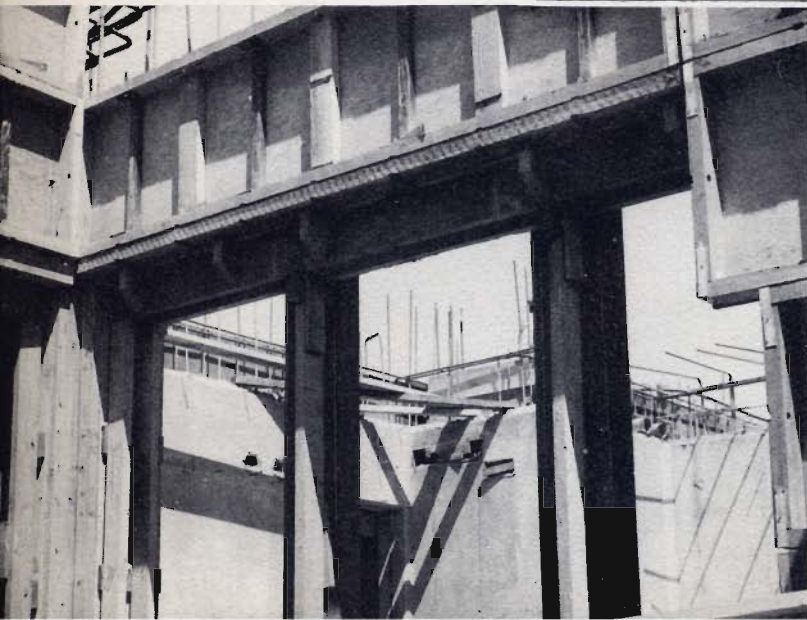
Dr. Bortolazzo pushing with all his might toward the new Stockton College which rapidly came closer and took the form of reality . . .
