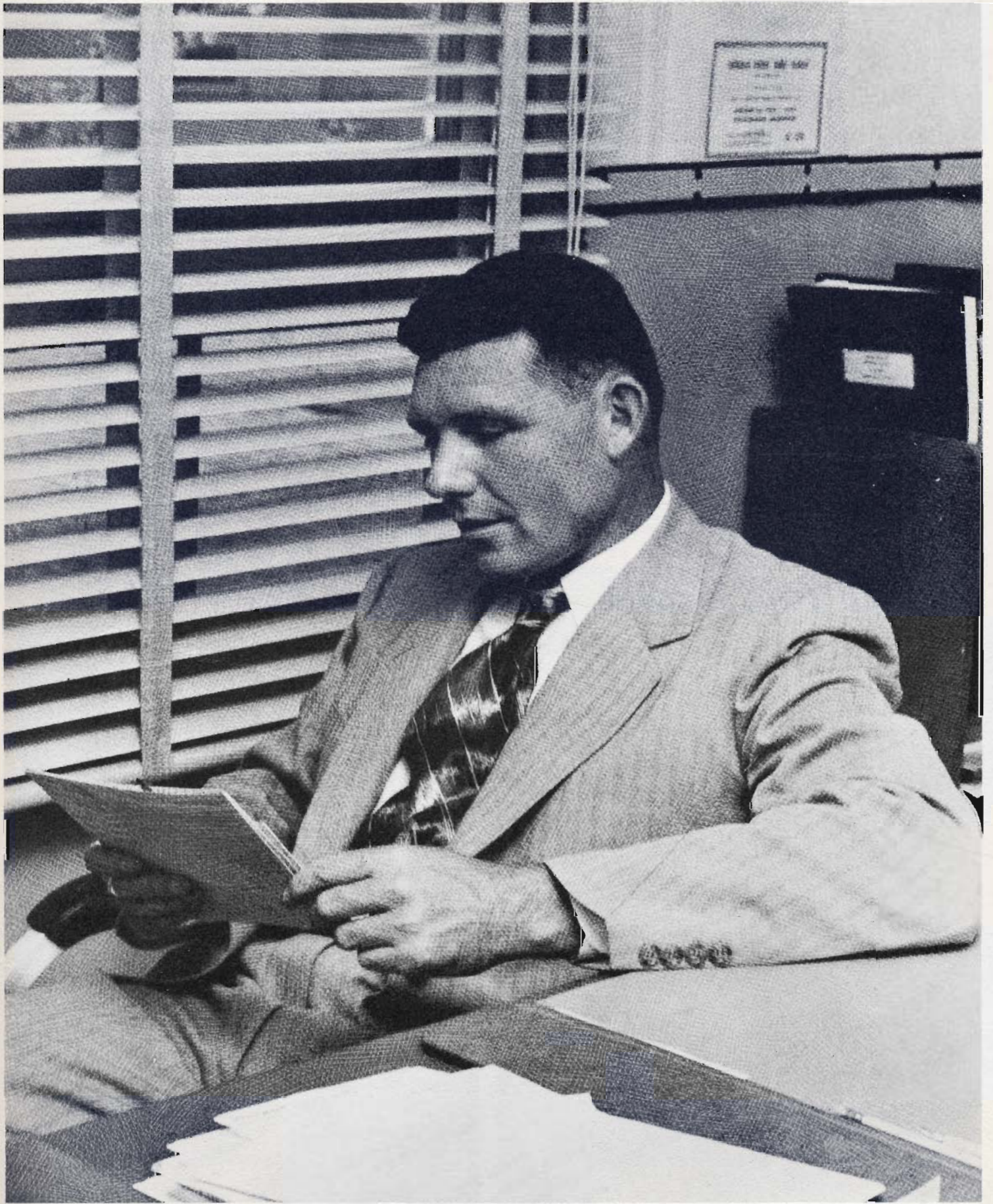

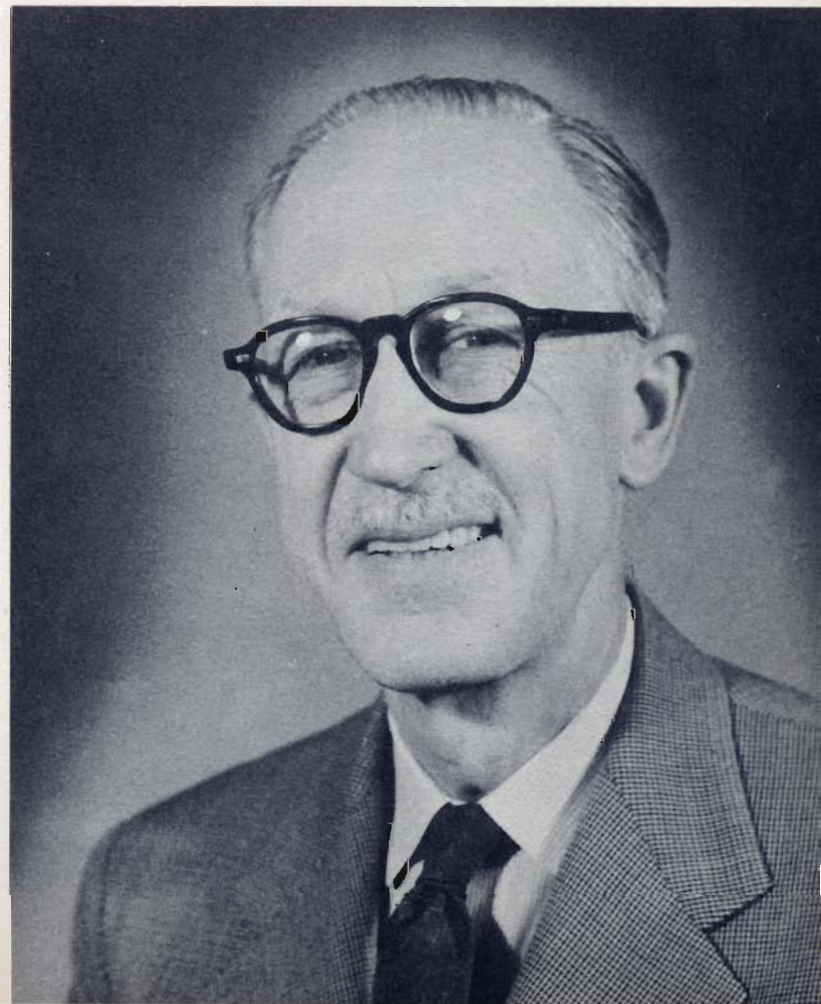


Burke W. Bradley

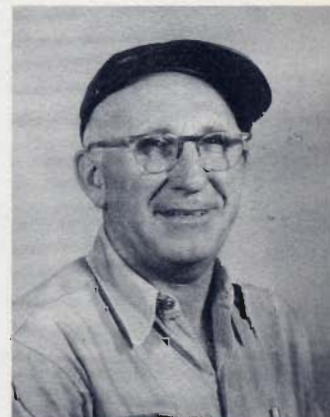

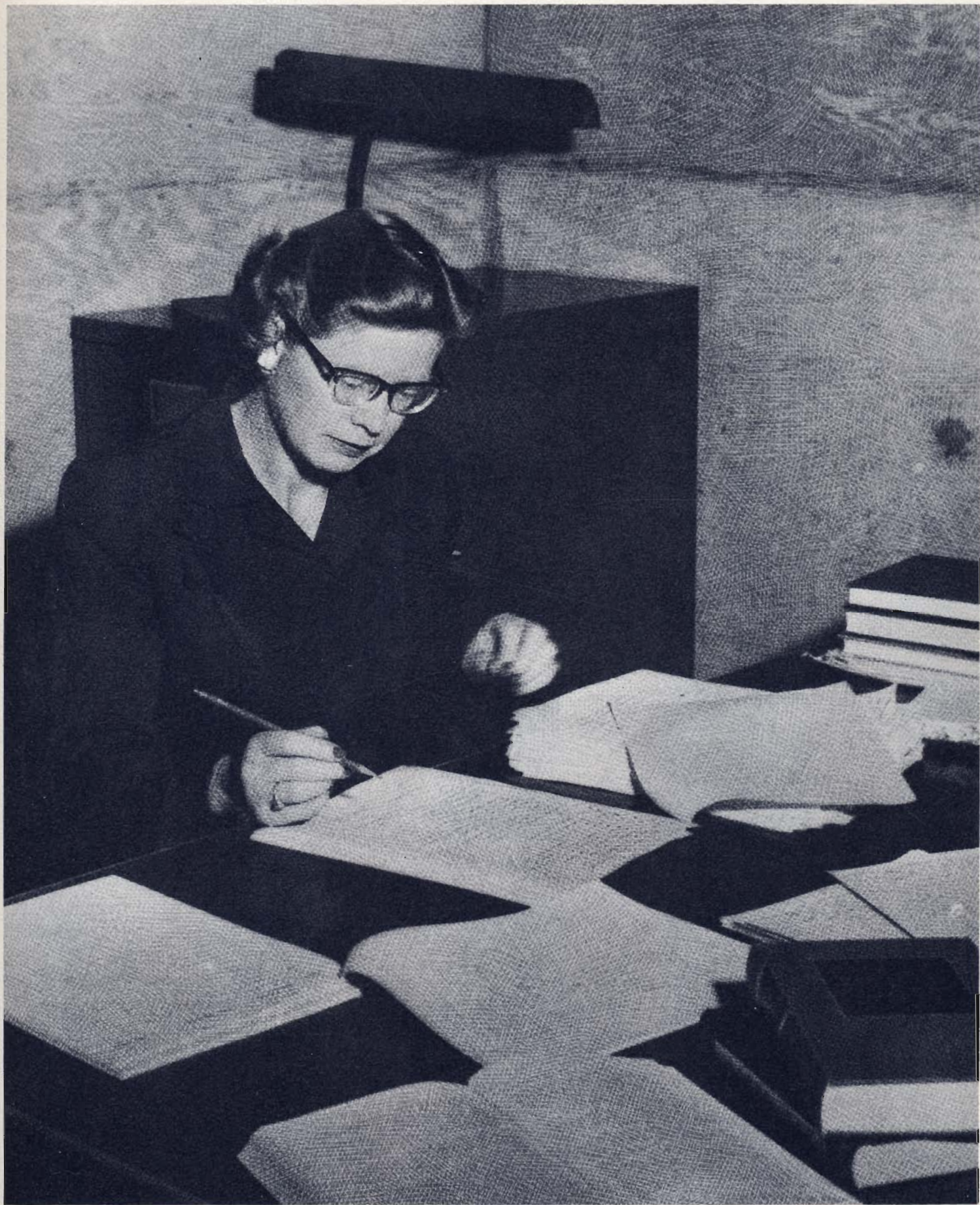
