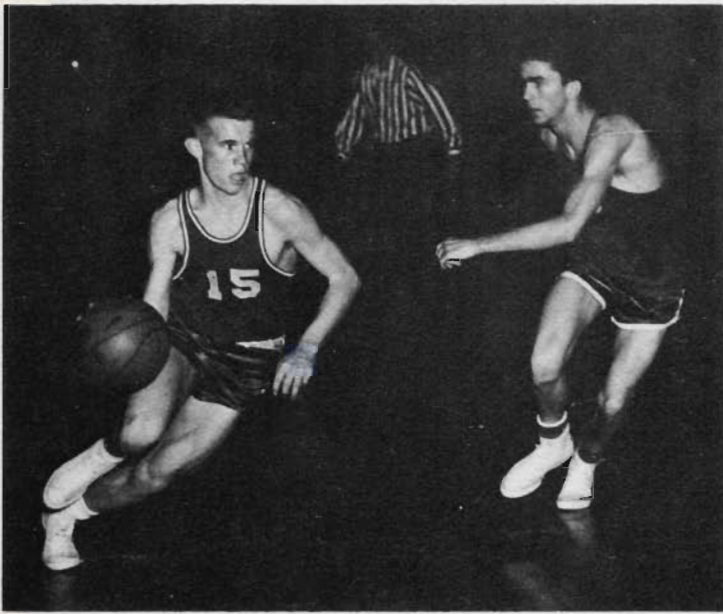

Waring (32) and Dwight Doerr (24) look on as Fellows (30) leaps, shoots and seems to pause in mid-air





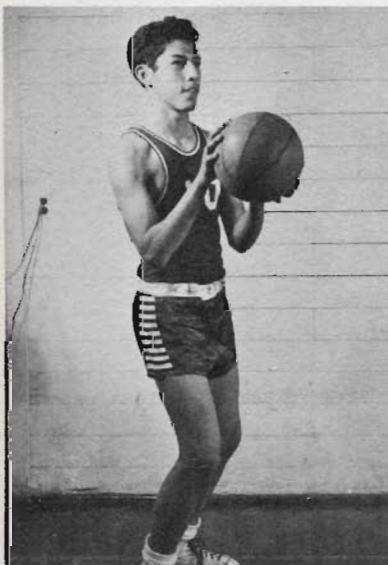

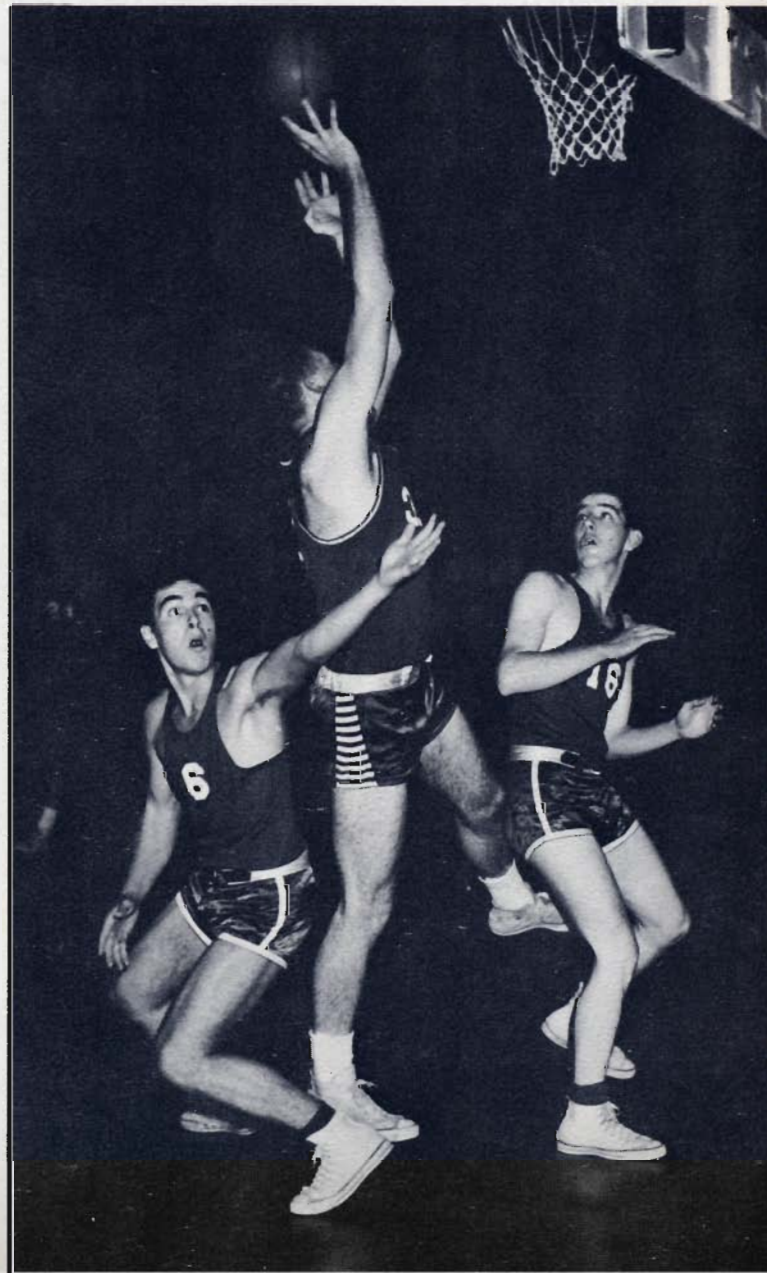

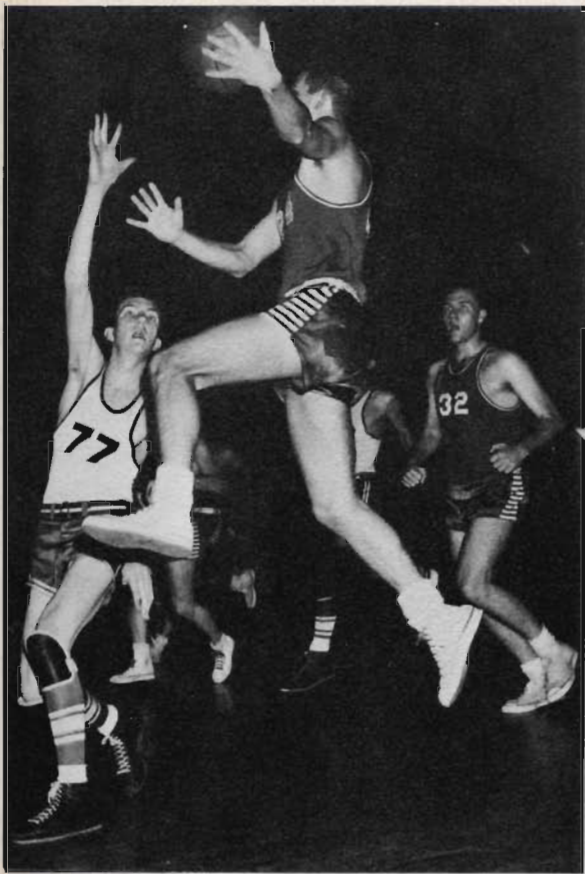
