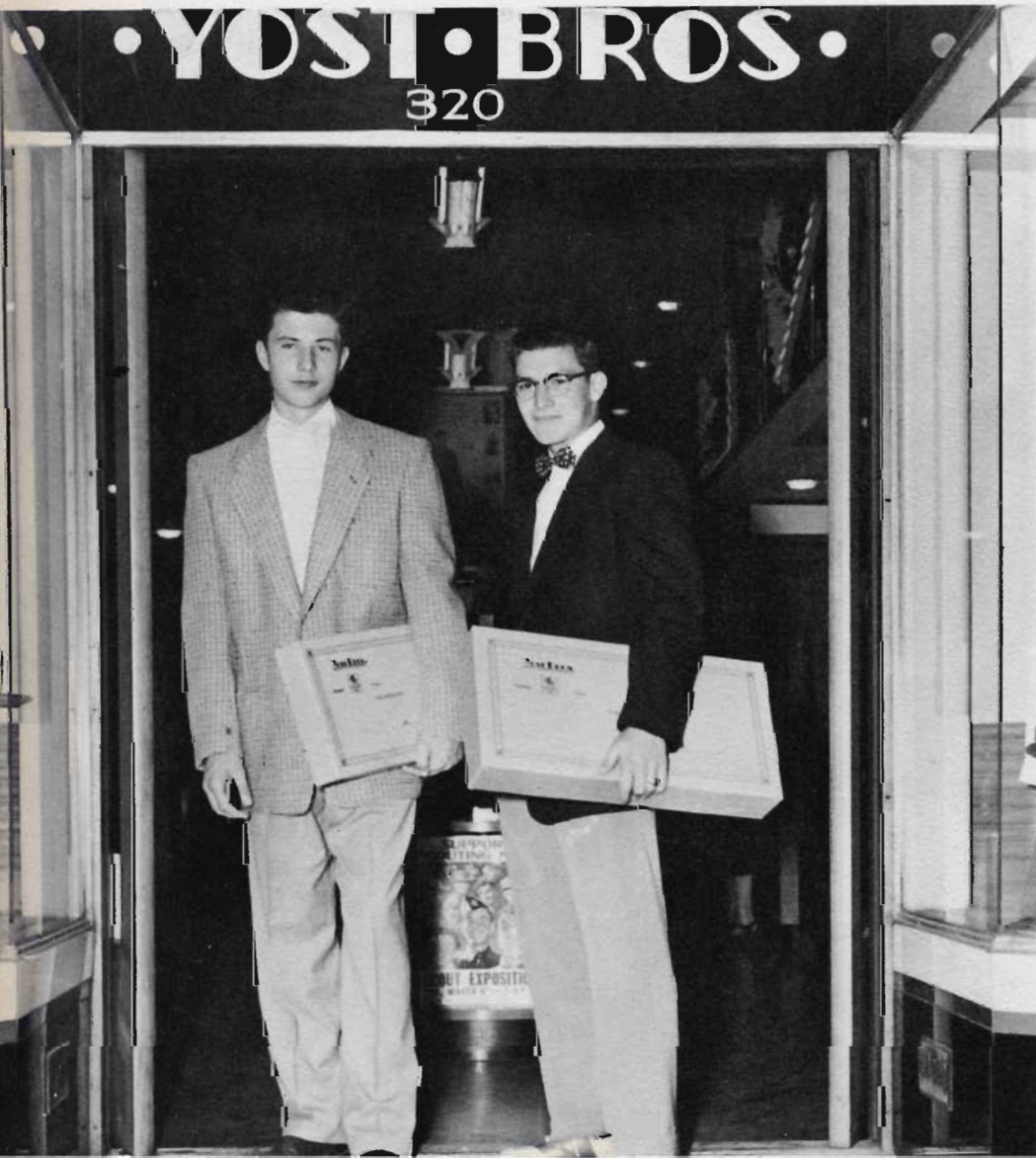


Dick's Drive Inn
