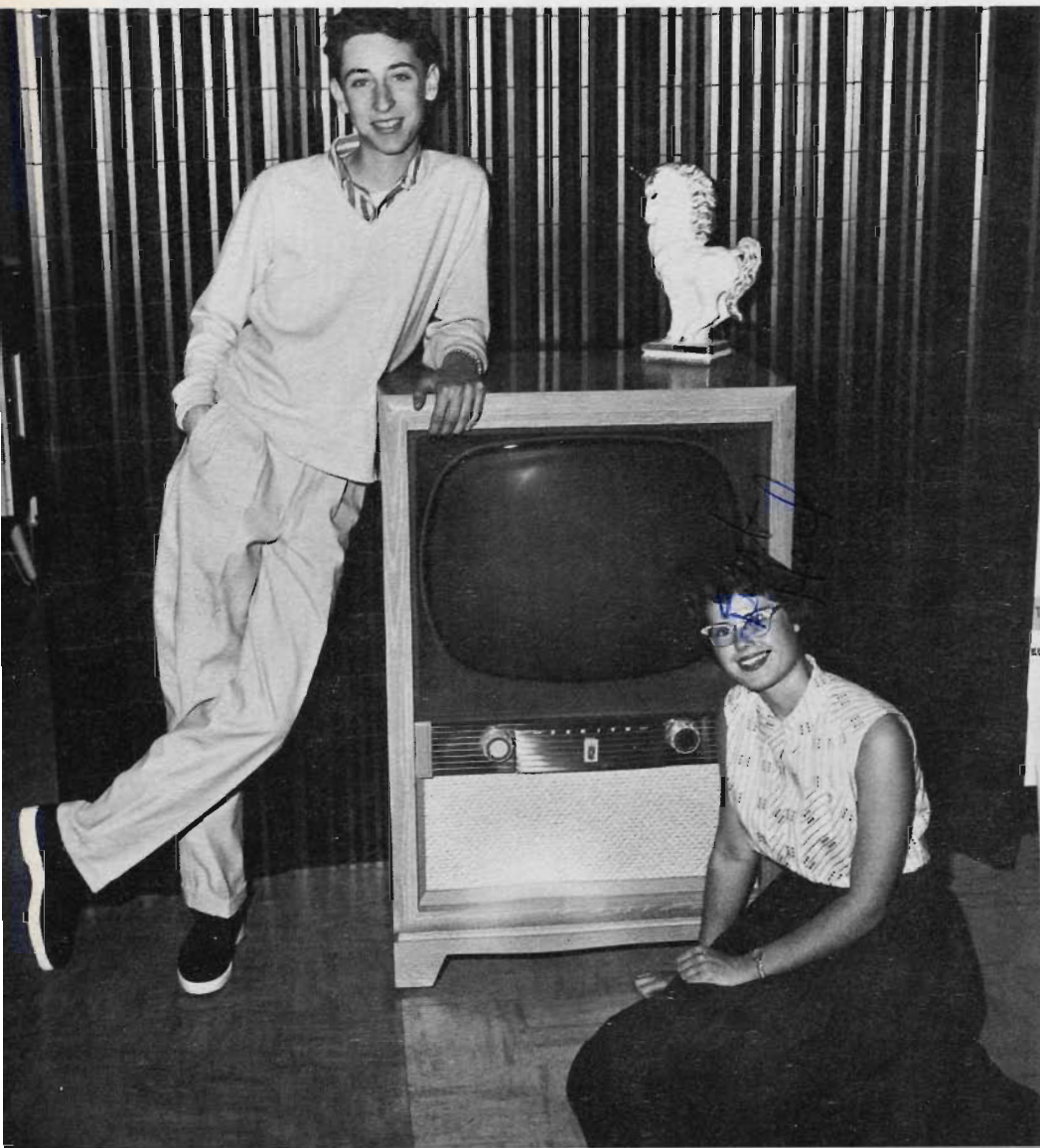


Nehi Bottling Co.

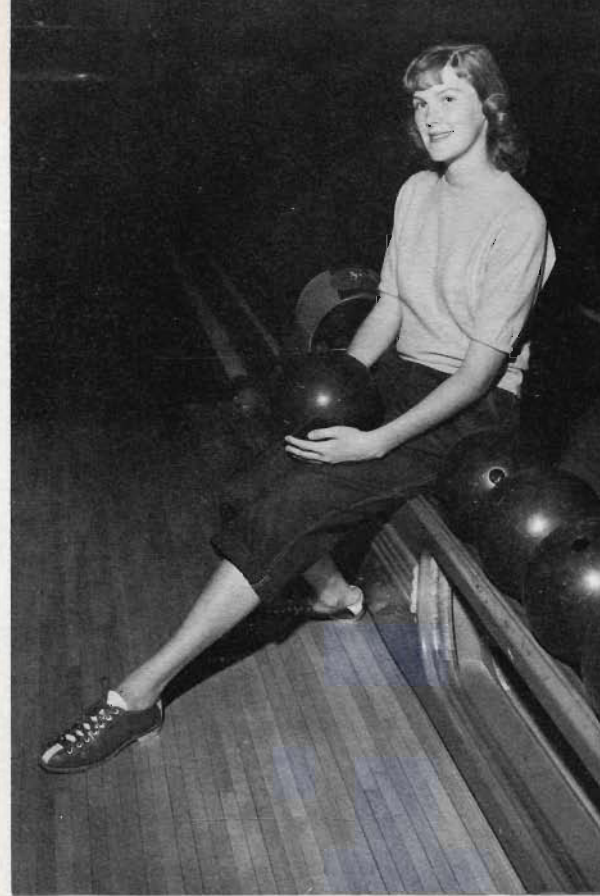

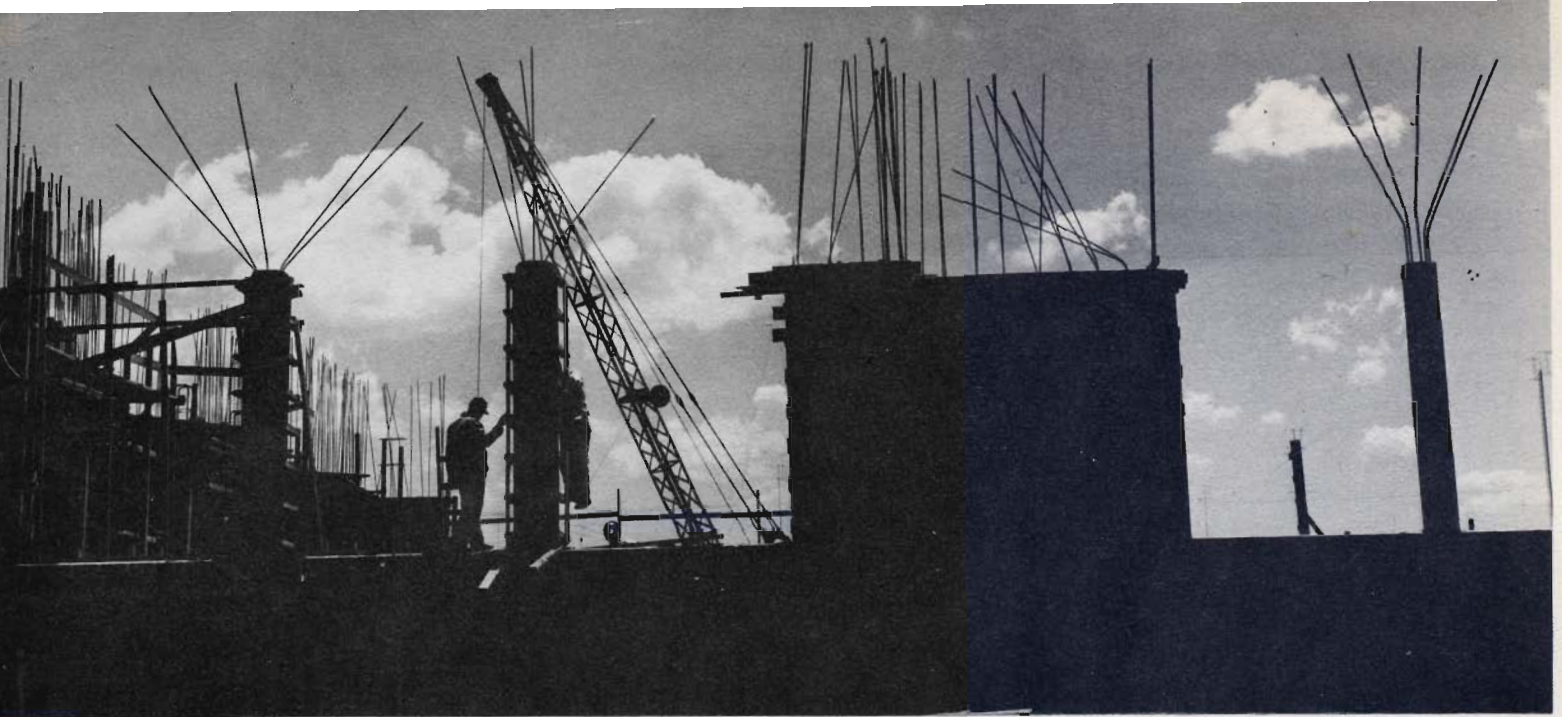

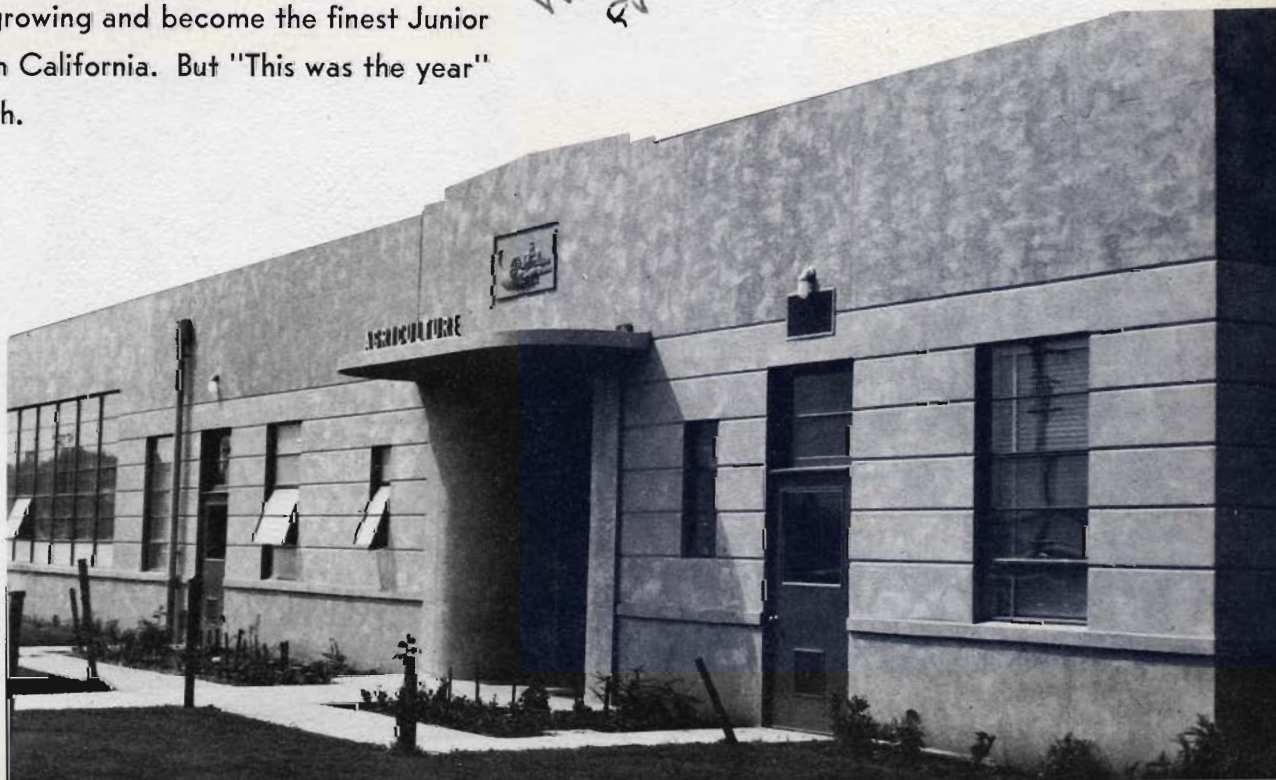
