## Fourteenth Year Women's Honorary Society

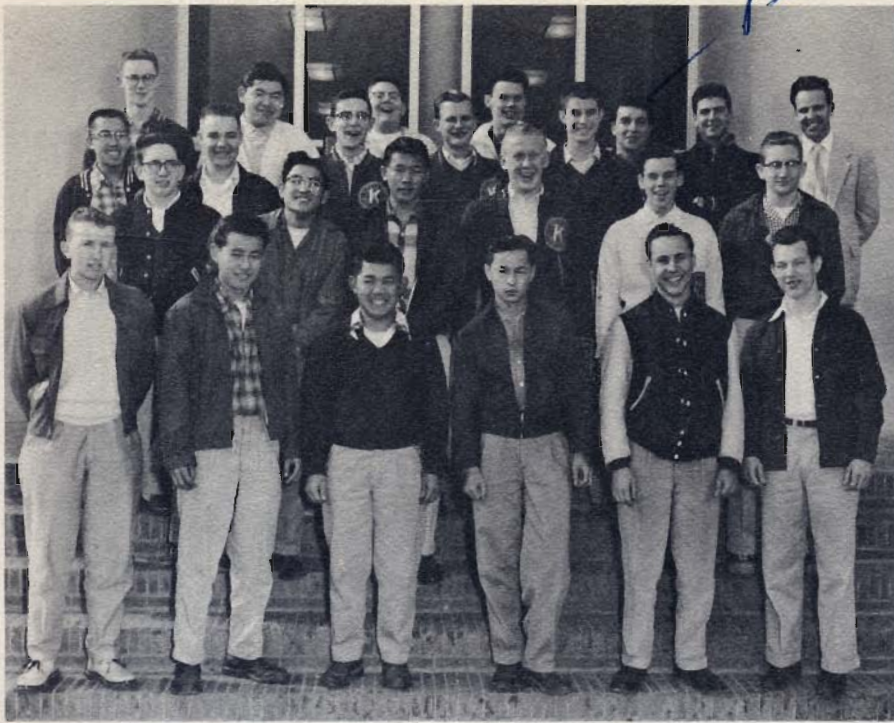
The cream of the crop! The Fourteenth Year Women's Honorary Society was an organization for women who retained a high scholastic average in their sophomore year of college work.
